Fair hours: Wed. & Thur. -11am-11 pm; Fri. & Sat. – 11am-Midnight

FUNPORIUM & Exhibit Buildings open to the public: Wed-Sat 11am-10 pm

Fair Office (Carriage House) hours: 9 am- 7 pm during Fair

Buildings are open to vendors at 10:00 am and to the public at 11 am. Use Livestock Gate or West Gate for Early-Entry. Buildings close at 10 pm.

## Package Delivery

If you have packages delivered to the Fair Office, it is your responsibility to pick up your packages without notification from Fair Staff. If your packages are arriving C.O.D., please arrange with Fair Staff .

## Insurance

All vendors are required to submit a certificate of insurance showing liability coverage

**Applications and Contracts - Commercial space applications require a \$100 reservation fee; this does not apply to Food Vendors.** If you do not receive a contract for space, the fee will be refunded. **Refunds will NOT be made for cancellations.** The Fair will try to honor requests for specific locations, but will not guarantee requested placement.

**Setup: Tuesday, August 2, 2022– 9:00 am to 9:00 pm AND Wednesday, August 3, 2022– 8:00 am to 10:00 am**

**Teardown: Saturday, Aug. 6, 2022 10pm- Midnight. No Vehicles allowed on grounds until after the Fair Closes. The building will remain open with security provided 2AM, Sunday, August 7, 2022 and again from 8 AM-Noon.**

**\*\*BOOTHS MUST REMAIN FULLY-OPERATIONAL THROUGH SATURDAY EVENING UNTIL THE BUILDING CLOSES. VENDORS WHO TEARDOWN THEIR BOOTHS EARLY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED BACK.**

## Vehicles and Parking

- Vehicles are allowed on the grounds only until 10:30 am daily. Vehicles may only enter through the Red Lot gate.
- Vendors will receive daily parking passes for use at either the West or South (public) parking lots.
- Only food vendors will be allowed to purchase Red Lot passes and must park in designated area listed on that pass, pass must remain visible on dash of vehicle showing vendor name and phone number.
- Vehicles not displaying appropriate passes in designated areas will be towed at owner's expense.
- Pedestrians may enter the Livestock (south lot) & West Gates beginning at 8:00 am
- The Fair office may exchange 5 daily parking passes for one Season Red Lot parking pass with proof of need in the form of a State-issued handicapped parking permit and the availability of parking space.
