CAMPING RULES

Camping Availability & Reservations

1. Water and electrical hook-ups are not guaranteed. Spaces are limited and based on availability.
2. Payment does not guarantee a camping space.
3. If electrical service is available, a 50-foot, 30-amp RV cord may be required.
4. Reservation forms and camping fees of \$250 must be received by the Fair Office by July 1, 2026.
5. Forms received after July 1, 2026, will be assessed a \$200 late fee.
6. No telephone reservations will be accepted.
7. Reservation forms must be complete. Incomplete forms will not be considered a reservation.
8. Camping spaces are reserved first for exhibitors and their immediate family members.
9. Priority will be given to large livestock exhibitors.
10. Submission of an application does not automatically guarantee a camping space.

Arrival, Check-In & Departure

11. All campers must stop in the main parking lot and check in with the Camping Director.
12. Camping space assignments will be provided upon arrival.
13. Campers must enter the fairgrounds Saturday, August 22, between 2:00 p.m.- 5:00 p.m.
14. No vehicles are permitted at campers after 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 23.
15. The camping entrance will be located at the horse gate entrance.
16. Campers must vacate the fairgrounds by August 30.

Electrical, Utilities & Sewer Services

17. Electrical usage is limited to a maximum 30-amp draw.
18. A 50-foot power cord is required; extension cords are not allowed.
19. Air conditioners may not be operated on fairgrounds power.
20. Small generators may be permitted at the discretion of the Fair Board.
21. The Fair assumes no responsibility for damage caused by electrical issues.
22. Sewer pumping service is available for \$20 per pump.
23. Sewer service must be requested on the registration form and paid with camping fees.

24. Sewer Pump Passes may be picked up at the Fair Office, they will not be distributed during camping check-in.

Camper Responsibility & Liability

25. Campers are responsible for the care, safety, and security of their campers, trailers, vehicles, and personal property.
26. The Fair, its staff, volunteers, and contracted service providers are not liable for loss, theft, damage, or injury.
27. By parking or setting up in the camping area, campers accept responsibility for any damage to their property, including incidental contact by service or maintenance vehicles.
28. Campers are encouraged to maintain appropriate insurance coverage.

Conduct, Safety & Supervision

29. Curfew for all persons staying on the grounds is midnight.
30. Curfew violations may result in expulsion from the grounds and forfeiture of premiums.
31. Campers without qualified adult supervision will be excluded from the grounds.
32. Names of all campers must be listed on the registration form.
33. Camping permits with the owner's name must be clearly displayed at all times.

Vehicles, Pets & Equipment

34. No dogs are allowed on the grounds at any time.
35. Failure to remove a dog may result in loss of camping privileges.
36. Unauthorized motorized vehicles (golf carts, ATVs, side-by-sides, motorcycles, etc.) are prohibited.
37. Only vehicles authorized by the Benton Franklin Fair Board may operate on fairgrounds property.
38. No vehicles are allowed on the grounds during the Fair, including the horse area.
39. Unauthorized vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

Space Requirements & Equipment

40. A 10-foot emergency and fire access lane must be maintained between rows of campers at all times.
41. RVs must be of a type approved by the Fair Board.
42. If there is any question regarding RV eligibility, contact the Fair Office.
43. Small tents are allowed only if they fit within the assigned camping space.
44. If additional space is required, two camping spaces must be reserved.
45. No campfires are allowed on the fairgrounds, including portable propane fire rings.

Passes & Credentials

46. Parent passes, exhibitor passes, and exhibitor numbers may be picked up at the Fair Office they will not be distributed during camping check-in.
