1. Entries to be dropped off Sun., 8/23, between 10am – 6pm in Building 3.
2. All exhibits will be released Sun., 8/30, from 8am –10am. Fair personnel and Superintendents are not responsible for items left after 10am.
3. LIMIT: Five entries per class, per exhibitor.
4. All competitive pieces must be the handiwork of the exhibitor, completed in the past year, and not exhibited previously at the Benton Franklin Fair. Entries must be done on cast earthen greenware, clay thrown on a wheel, or hand-built from pottery clay which has been fired and decorated, and ready for exhibit. Enter only one piece of set (e.g. canisters) except for natives and chess sets, which must be entered entirely. Plates or plaques must be on a stand for display. Do not put felt on the bottom of pieces except for bookends and chess pieces (all bottoms must be finished).
5. Fused glass entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
