- 3. LIMIT: 6 entries per exhibitor with no class limitations.
- 4. Only original work executed by the entrant will be accepted. Work must be completed during the past 3 years and not exhibited at a previous Benton Franklin Fair.
- 5. All entries <u>must</u> be the original work of the entrant, suitably framed (if applicable), and ready to hang with <u>screw eyes and wire</u>. Tape, yarn, string, and small hooks that come on frames are <u>not</u> acceptable methods to hang. Without proper hangers, entries will not be accepted.
- 6. Unframed entries will **not** be accepted. (if applicable)
