Before entering, please refer to Entry instructions for Rules and Regulations.

1. Booths shall be judged and awarded ribbons: 1st through 5th place. Remaining placings will receive participation ribbons. Ribbons will be displayed on the booths and remain there throughout the Fair.
2. Displays must be set up by 2 p.m. Monday to be judged.
3. Displays must be taken down on Sunday by 4 p.m.
4. There are 2 sections to the display:
 - a. Top Section
 - i. 4' x 8'
 - ii. Sits upright.
 - b. Bottom Section
 - i. 8' x 8'
 - ii. Sits sloping downward at an approximate 25-degree angle.

FFA Display Score Card

Educational Value - 30

Does the booth present a clear, understood, educational message concerning the agriculture industry, food production or the FFA Organization?

Quality Construction – 30

Is the display constructed in a neat and appealing manner with materials appropriate to the message presented?

General Appearance – 30

Does the display do a good job presenting the FFA organization in a positive manner to the fair visitors?

Fair Theme – 10

Is the theme of this year's fair clearly presented in the display?

TOTAL – 100

Each booth receiving 65 or more points shall receive booth guarantee of \$150.
