1. Spring heifer calf, born on or after 3/1/2025 and over four months of age at show time
2. Winter heifer calf, born between 12/1/24 & 2/28/2025
3. Fall heifer calf, born between 9/1/24 & 11/30/24
4. Summer yearling heifer, born between 6/1/24 & 8/31/24
5. Spring yearling heifer, born between 3/1/24 & 5/31/24
6. Winter yearling heifer, born between 12/1/23 & 2/28/24
7. Fall yearling heifer, born between 9/1/23 & 11/30/23

8. Junior Get-of-Sire, four animals under two years of age, the get of the same sire, sire must be named, must have been shown as individuals, one entry only.
9. Two-year-old cow, born between 9/1/22 and 8/31/23
10. Three-year-old cow, born between 9/1/21 and 8/31/22
11. Four-year-old cow, born between 9/1/20 and 8/31/21
12. Aged cow, born before 9/1/20

13. Best three females, any age, all bred and owned by exhibitor and shown as individuals. Only one entry per exhibitor.

14. Dairy herd, four cows that have freshened, all owned by exhibitor and shown as individuals, only one entry per exhibitor.
15. Produce of Dam, two animals, any age, the produce of one cow. Dam must be named; produce must have been shown as individuals. Only one entry per dam.
16. Daughter and Dam, one cow with one of her daughters, must have been shown as individuals.
17. Senior Get-of-Sire, four animals, the get of one sire, must be two years old or older, must have been shown as individuals, sire must be named. One entry only.

## Dairy Judging

- This contest is open to any member enrolled in Youth (4-H/Grange). Contestants must be prepared to demonstrate skills and give written or oral reasons.
- Dairy Judging contest will only happen if there are enough dairy cattle to have multiply classes to make it a State Qualifying contest.
