Before entering, please refer to General Information for Youth (4-H/Grange) & FFA Livestock Departments, Livestock Rules and Regulations and Youth Rules. During the Fair it is important to check information board in the barn for any changes. Please see Registration Dates and Entry Days for those times and locations.

- Pre-registration is mandatory.
- All exhibitors will be required to sign release form regarding their bird's health before their fowl will be allowed into the building.
- Exhibitor number is required on each animal cage tag. Failure to do so will result in forfeited premiums.
- Cloverbud and peewee exhibitors should enter their birds in Dept. 7 – Open Class Birds.

- B. Large chickens – Birds to be judged by APA standards; must list breed, variety, sex and age category on cage tag
- C. Bantam – Birds to be judged by APA standards; must list breed, variety, sex and age category on cage tag

CLASS

- 1. Single Bird
- 2. Trio – Two Females, One Male

DIVISION

- D. Egg Production – All breeds of chicken judged for their capability to produce eggs; must list young or old on the cage tag.
- E. Meat Chickens – All breeds of birds judged for meat production, list weight and age on cage tag.

CLASS

- 1. Single Layer or fryer
- 2. Pen of three layers or fryers

DIVISION

- F. Ducks – must list variety, sex, and age category on cage tag

CLASS

- 1. Small breed (under 5 lbs. Mature)
- 2. Medium breed (5 to 8 lbs. Mature)
- 3. Large breed (over 8 lbs. Mature)

DIVISION

- G. Geese – must list variety, sex and age category on cage tag

CLASS

1. Standard bird
2. Young meat bird; may be crossbred

DIVISION

- H. Turkeys – must list variety, sex and age category on cage tag.
I. Feather birds – all species salable for feather crafts

1. All species

- J. Eggs – no limit

CLASS

1. White - displayed in 12 count carton
2. Brown – displayed in 12 count carton
3. Exotic, naturally colored – displayed in 12 count carton
4. Collection: variety or chicken duck, goose and turkey – displayed to suit collection
5. Easter, decorated by exhibitor – displayed to suit or enhance

AUCTION RULES

1. Auction is open to Youth (4-H/Grange) junior, intermediate, and senior exhibitors in Dept. 37 – 4-H & FFA Pigeons, Game Birds and Cage Birds and Dept. 38 – Youth (4-H/Grange) & FFA Poultry.
2. To enter auction, first register online under Division K; then fill out the description form and return it to the poultry superintendent before Wed 8/21, 10 p.m.
3. Each exhibitor will be limited to two lots, but lot may be single, pair or trio.
4. The Birds sold may be sold as meat birds, egg producers or breeders.
5. The entries will be sold by the lot, regardless of the number of birds in it.
6. Birds sold must be exhibited and judged at the fair.
7. Each exhibitor may only sell birds shown in his/her name.
8. Exhibitor must show birds at the sale time or make arrangements for help.
9. \$2.00 per lot will be deducted from sale check.
10. Birds sold at the auction will be released from 8-10 a.m. Sun., 8/25, unless special arrangements have been made with superintendent.

- K. Auction – Sign up online for payment and turn in description form at poultry office.

CLOVERBUD AND PEE-WEE SHOWMANSHIP

Sign-up on Mon., Aug. 19 at the poultry barn for children not old enough to be in 4-H. Animals must already be entered in either open class or Youth (4-H/Grange) and must be on grounds. NOTE: No premiums paid in this division. Cloverbud and PeeWee exhibitors should enter their birds in Dept. 7 Open Class.
