During the registration process you will need to submit a photo of the exhibitor, their hog and the 840 tag physically in the ear. In the event the tag falls out before weigh-in please contact the superintendent ASAP. Once approved, you will receive a new 840 tag from the Benton Franklin Market Stock Committee during weigh-in.
- Youth (4-H/Grange) clubs will show in all divisions together.
- Youth Fitting and Showing, Breeding and Special Divisions will be classified by age regardless of what club you are in.
- No hogs are to leave the barn at any time during the fair week.
