YOUTH EDUCATIONAL DISPLAYS

Register Online Here!

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SUPERINTENDENT:

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Before entering, please refer to 4-H and FFA Rules for rules and regulations on our website at www.bentonfranklinfair.com.

1. **Registration Requirement:**

- Exhibitors must register separately for each department regardless of being registered to show an animal.
- Exhibitors must register each poster separately within their respective divisions. For example, if submitting 3 educational posters, exhibitors need to register 3 entries.

2. **Deadline for Registration & Poster Pick Up:**

- All entries must be registered by midnight on 7/31/2026. Late registrations will not be accepted.
- Posters will be available for pick up on 8/22/2026 - 8/23/2026 from 10am - 6pm in the 4-H building.
- The person picking up the posters will be required to sign posters and ribbons out.

3. **Judging and Premiums:**

- Entries not registered by the midnight deadline and not included in the final paperwork picked up by the superintendent from the Fair office on 8/3/2026 will not be judged. Consequently, premiums will not be awarded.

4. **Submission Deadline:**

- Posters can be dropped off Pasco 4-H Extension office 07/22-07/24/2026 from noon to 4pm every day. Lamination will be available price TBD and announced by the 4-H Council.
- All Posters must be dropped off by 4pm on July 24th, 2026, at the Pasco 4-H Extension office unless other arrangements have been made with the superintendent.

5. **Information Attachment to the back of the poster:**

- Please complete the form provided on the last page of the Youth Educational Display Guidelines document. Afterward, print the document, cut it down, and attach it with glue to the bottom left-hand corner of the poster. This facilitates easy identification during judging and pickup.

6. **Recommendation:**

- It is recommended (**though not mandatory**) to have posters laminated to prevent damage during handling. This is especially important as posters are often touched multiple times before being placed on display

7. **Glue Usage Requirement:**
 - Please only use glue, preferably rubber cement, (. Rubber cement is recommended for its easy removal if there is any excess.) when putting posters together. If anything, other than glue is used, the entry will not be judged, and no premiums will be awarded.
8. **Exhibitor Responsibility:**
 - Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that their entries are registered, properly assembled, glued, and prepared according to the guidelines. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.
9. **Scoring:**
 - Once an exhibit is scored, the superintendent is not authorized to change the score at any given time. The judge's evaluation and decision are final.

**** If your poster was created digitally and is being entered for buckle competition, it must be registered through the STEM Department (Dept. 45). Digitally created posters that will be displayed in the barns and are not competing for a buckle will remain in Dept. 46.**
