Before entering, please refer to Entry Instructions and Youth (4-H/Grange) & FFA Rules for rules and regs.

- 1. Entries to be dropped off Sun., Aug. 18, between 10 a.m.-6 p.m. in Building 4.
- 2. All exhibits will be released Sun., Aug. 25, from 8 a.m.–10 a.m. Fair personnel and Superintendents are not responsible for items remaining after 10 a.m.
- 3. Limit 2 entries per Division.
- 4. Entries shall be the original, unpublished work of the exhibitor and not previously exhibited at the fair.
- 5. Poems not to exceed 50 lines.
- 6. Short Fiction and Essays must be doubled spaced with 1 inch margins and with pages sequentially numbered. Short Fiction and Essays must not exceed 1500 words.
- 7. Font size must be equivalent to Arial 12.
- 8. Submit two copies of each entry as follows:
- 9. Creative Writing and Poetry copy one is for judging. All entries must be DOUBLE-SPACED with 1-inch margins. Short Fiction and Essays shall have pages sequentially numbered. They shall have exhibitor's name, title of work, Division, and Class. It must be submitted on 8 ½ x 11 white paper, using Arial font size 12, in black ink.
- 10. Copy two is for display purposes and shall have the Title and exhibitor's name on the **FRONT** and Division and Class **ON THE BACK**. It can include drawings, illustrations, or any artwork you wish to add. Poems MUST be matted or framed, and Short Fiction and Essays MUST be in a Presentation Folder.
- 11. Entries will be judged on the following criteria: Creativity, Originality, Grammar, Spacing, Font, Spelling, Punctuation and APPEARANCE AND QUALITY OF THE DISPLAY COPY.
