- 14. Senior get-of-sire, to consist of at least one milking doe (refer to rule #5)
- 15. Produce of dam, to consist of two does from the same dam.
- 16. Dam and daughter, any age female.
- 17. Three generations or more.
- 18. Breeder's herd, to consist of four does, any age, bred and owned by exhibitor. One herd per exhibitor, per breed.
- 19. Dairy herd, to consist of four does in milk. All must be owned by exhibitor. One herd per exhibitor, per breed. (refer to rule #5). (Boers do not need to be in milk.)
