A chart, graph, mobile, poster, (minimum size 14" x 22") or game or table display (24" x 36") showing work done in project in which 4-Her is enrolled. Each exhibit must have a 3" x 5" card stating: project enrolled in, what area of the project is being presented, if it is a game or educational display and how it will be used, and target age of child item made for.
