DIVISION

A. Clothing Expo

CLASS

1. Management Contest

- a. Contestants must be enrolled in a clothing project.
 - b. 4-H members enrolled in Sewing for Fun may construct an item that is not a garment
 - c. This is a clothing construction activity. There will be a 2 ½ hour time limit to complete the garment. Participants may be asked to give a verbal explanation to the public as to what the contest requirements are and what they are making.
 - d. A sewing center will be set up for each contestant. The sewing center will include a working space and an ironing board.
 - e. Contestants must bring their own sewing machines, irons, and extension cords.
 - f. Contestants must provide care information. A care label must be sewn into the garment with the care information detailed.
 - g. Contestants will model their completed garment for the judge. Bring any other pieces of the outfit to wear with the garment during modeling. The garment will be left for display for the remainder of the Fair.
 - h. Garment may be cut out, marked, stay stitched and pinned before the activity.
2. Talk Skill Demonstration
- a. Any 20-30-minute skill demonstration showing a particular clothing or textile technique. This activity must show skill. The demonstration may relate to textiles, equipment, or purchased garments.

DIVISION

- B. Performing Arts
- a. Non-judged activity
 - b. Pre-registration required.
 - c. Note length of performance at sign-up.
 - d. A PA system will be available. All other equipment must be provided by the exhibitor.
 - e. Clubs are encouraged to sign up in blocks and provide a master of ceremonies. The MC may sign up as an exhibitor.
 - f. Exhibit may consist of singing, dancing to music, puppetry, drama, comedy, etc.
- C. 4-H in Action
- a. A one or two-hour event to share an activity with the public, any subject.
 - b. This activity is judged daily.
 - c. Guidelines for this activity are available from the superintendent or the cooperative extension office.
 - d. Pre-registration is required.
 - e. A PA system, table and easels will be available. You will be required to provide all additional equipment needed.
 - f. Video photography projects may be included in the class.

- g. Building herdsmanship is a four-hour event with three or six club members to share activity (interaction) with the public on any 4-H subject/project in the 4-H/FFA building.

2. Senior Individual – Ribbon Only
3. Club or Team Activity – Ribbon Only
