1. Entries to be dropped off Sun., Aug. 18, between 10 a.m.–6 p.m. or Monday before 1 p.m. in Building 1.
2. All exhibits will be released Sun., Aug. 25, from 8 a.m.–10 a.m. **Fair personnel and Superintendents are not responsible for items left after 10 a.m.**
3. Fleece may be moved from one lot to another at the discretion of the judge. Fleece must be in a clear plastic bag; no tied fleeces.
4. All fleeces will be judged on hand-spinning quality, character, stressing cleanliness, strength, and uniformity.
5. LIMIT: Two fleece per class.
6. A 3x5 card with the following information must accompany the entry: breed of animal, age of animal and number of growth months.
