SANDREGULATIONS

FRIDAY, JANUARY 27 thru SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 4

ENTRY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. All breed entries must be calved after January 1, 2021 and prior to June 1, 2022.
- 2. An original or copy of the registration papers must accompany your registration. All cattle entries must be accompanied by a registration number.
- 3. Entry must be received by November 15 with complete data or entry will not be accepted or cataloged.
- 4. All animals must meet their breed requirements for performance, genetic defect, pedigree, fitting, DOB and health as set forth by their individual rules.
- 5. Breeds are limited to a total consignment of 65 head. If necessary, cuts will be made at the discretion of the BHSS Livestock Committee, consultation with respective breed representatives, and based on consignor's preference of entry.
- 6. No miniatures will be allowed in any breed.
- 7. The Black Hills Stock Show and Rodeo® (BHSS) reserves the right to reject any or all entries.
- 8. Angus, Charolais, Hereford, Red Angus and Simmental breeders will be limited to three head, two of which can be bulls and all must be registered at time of entry deadline.
- 9. All animals must be owned by the consignor six months prior to Nov. 15. All Angus & Simmental entries must be first owners. Please note - animals must be entered as registered.
- 10. The BHSS Office must be notified of any livestock liens.
- 11. When providing check for payment, consignor authorizes BHSS to use information from check to make a one-time electronic transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction.
- 12. Breeds must maintain a minimum of 15 animals entered to keep their show and sale. Breeds that do not meet the minimum will be on probation for one year. If the breed fails to meet the minimum of 15 entries for two consecutive years their show and sale will be discontinued.

SHOW/SALE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 13. Check-in time for all animals is 11AM at the scale in the back of Rushmore Hall. All animals must be checked in the day prior to Show/Sale day.
- 14. Arrival Schedule: Livestock may be stalled in the barn no earlier than 6PM two days prior to your respective Show/Sale day and no later than 7PM on the day of their Show/Sale day. (Please see Barn Arrival Schedule in breed rules to confirm your arrival schedule.)
- 15. The following will be required for check-in no later than 12PM on the day before the Show/Sale.
 - Proof of registration or other acceptable certificate for each animal. Any animal without proper registration certificate will not be allowed to enter the Show/Sale ring. NO EXCEPTIONS!!! Please note - registration number must be provided on the entry form.
 - Current health certificate, see Health & Brand Requirement section for specific information that should be provided to your veterinarian. The BHSS follows State Import Regulations. Questions pertaining to health certificates should be directed to the SD Animal Industry Board at (605)773-3321.
 - Brand Inspection (if applicable), see Health & Brand Requirement Section, Rule 26 for specific information.

SUBSTITUTIONS

- 16. Following the entry deadline, the BHSS office will allow substitution for a \$35 fee.
- 17. Bulls must be substituted for bulls and heifers substituted for heifers, owner for owner.
- 18. Any additional or updated information regarding animals entered is at the expense of the consignor. Announcements are made at the auction block.

HEALTH AND BRAND REQUIREMENTS

- 19. All cattle entering the Show/Sale from outside South Dakota shall meet the South Dakota Livestock Import requirements including a current health certificate, permit, individual animal identifications, and certain tests and treatment depending on the state of origin.
- 20. All cattle entering the Show/Sale from within South Dakota shall have a current health certificate with individual animal identification.
- 21. Any animal infected with communicable diseases. including ringworm, warts and lice, will not be accepted for the Show/Sale.
- 22. All females shall be officially calfhood vaccinated for Brucellosis with the vaccination tattoo listed on the health certificate.
- 23. All heifers 15 months or younger must be open and declared open on the health certificate.
- 24. All heifers 16 months and older must be bred and declared bred on the health certificate, and guaranteed bred by the consignor (excluding individual breed rules).
- 25. All bulls 13 months and older shall be semen tested within 25 days prior to the Show/Sale and have a satisfactory result declared on the health certificate. All bulls 18 months or older must have a negative trich test per law. Younger bulls only if a virgin must be marked so on the health certificate.
- 26. Additional animal disease testing may be performed at the discretion of the consignor if they anticipate the need to meet certain special post-sale interstate or international shipping requirements or to enhance marketability. Please provide copies of these test results.
- 27. Brand Inspection—Livestock coming from a brand inspection state into South Dakota must have a market clearance or local inspection. Proof of ownership must be available. All livestock sold or leaving the brand area of South Dakota must have a brand inspection certificate or market clearance prior to leaving the Stock Show.
 - Questions pertaining to Brand Inspection should be directed to the SD Brand Board at (605) 773-3324.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 28. Screening of all animals will be done by a panel under the direction of the Black Hills Stock Show ® Livestock Committee. Screened animals will not be allowed to enter the sale ring and all entry fees will be forfeited. Screened animals must be immediately removed from the barn by the owner. Any animal not shown will be considered screened.
- 29. Cattle will be ear tagged with lot number at check-in time.
- 30. Cattle may be removed from the livestock barn for tieouts after 6PM. No cattle are allowed in the barn over
- 31. There is VERY limited room for fitting chutes in Rushmore Hall. Space is not guaranteed along the north

SAFETY REOUIREMENTS:

- 32. To minimize consignor's liability for any damage or injury caused by loose animals, bulls are required to have nose leads at all times in The Monument, including in the show and sale ring.
- 33. Animals must be under control at all times. Wild or uncontrollable animals will be disqualified and asked to leave the facility immediately.

EXPENSES

- 34. The BHSS office will deduct 4% off the total sale price.
- 35. Livestock consignors at the previous year's BHSS consignor meetings vote on approved expenses such as breed auctioneers, breed advertising, state breed associations and other approved expenses.
- 36. All catalog fees must be paid for at the time of entry. Catalog fee for bulls is \$150 and females is \$130 before November 10th. November 11th-15th entry fee is a flat \$225/hd. 25 dollars from all female fees will go to the Black Hills Gold Youth Futurity Show prize money. Entry fees per animal is in addition to expenses.
- 37. All animals receiving a bid of \$4,000 or more, but not sold, will be automatically charged 12% sales commission, plus expenses listed in Rule 34. All animals receiving a bid of less than \$4,000, but not sold, will be automatically charged an 8% sales commission, plus expenses listed in Rule 34. All animals that do not receive a bid will be charged a 4% sales commission of a \$1,000 selling price, plus expenses listed in Rule 34.

SALE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 38. All animals offered for sale, will be sold without reservation to the highest bidder. A check to the BHSS shall be written for each animal that enters the sale ring. A minimum of 50% interest must sell on all animals sold. Possessions will be negotiated between buyer and seller.
- 39. Terms of every sale are cash with settlement to be made with the Sale Clerk at the time of sale. Consignors and/ or representatives should be prepared to pay the total price in the absence of the buyer.
- 40. The BHSS will make checks payable to the registered brand holder of the animal.
- 41. All disputes as to bids will be settled from the auction block. After the sale, disputes will be settled by the BHSS Livestock Committee.
- 42. The buyer will assume all risk on animals as soon as they are declared sold.
- 43. After an animal is sold, it will be led from the Sale Ring to its tie. Sold animals must be removed from the barn prior to 6PM. Stalling is available at the Central States

- Fairgrounds. Consignors should make proper arrangements with buyers for care of the animals. Sold animals cannot be removed from the building until they receive a load-out slip.
- 44. The consignor is responsible for transferring registration of the animal.
- 45. Heifers will show first and sell last.
- 46. Each consignor accepts the responsibility of guaranteeing his own cattle to be in sound condition and have the privilege of giving additional guarantee on cattle at the time of sale in the ring. The BHSS acts only as an agent for the consignors in the sale and does not assume any responsibility for the animal's future usefulness. All guarantees are strictly between the buyer and seller.
- 47. Changes regarding information in the catalog will be announced from the auctioneer's block and such announcements will take precedence.

BLACK HILLS STOCK SHOW & RODEO® MANAGEMENT

- 48. The BHSS general halter rules takes precedence over individual breed rules.
- 49. The BHSS Management reserves the right to final and absolute decision regarding any issue involving the livestock show or sales. Final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and the right to settle and determine all matters, questions or differences in regard hereto, or otherwise arising out of, or connected with, or incident to, the show and sale be reserved to the Black Hills Stock Show® Management.
- 50. The BHSS, the Management, The Monument, or anyone helping with the Show/Sale assumes no responsibility for accident or injury. The BHSS Management/Personnel or the Monument Management/Personnel will not be responsible for any injury or loss of any animal or accident thereby.
- 51. The BHSS® is a member of the North American Livestock Show and Rodeo Managers Association.



ANGUS

MONDAY, JANUARY 30 SHOW 9AM. SALE 1PM

- 1. A single Angus consignor is limited to three consignments, two of which can be bulls. All Angus bulls must be weighed prior to the show and sale.
- 2. All Angus cattle are to be genetic defect free from all known defects, which are listed in the suggested sale 2. terms and conditions published by the American Angus Association. Carriers will be disqualified from the show and sale. All scratches and/or substitutions will be at the discretion of the Breed Representatives and with the approval of the BHSS Livestock Committee.
- 3. There is a limit of 45 bulls and 20 females.
- 4. All angus entries must be first owner.
- 5. Consignors are required to assist the buyer in transporting cattle to the fairgrounds pending further travel arrangements.

Eligibility Requirements; Limousin cattle with an orange registration certificate, must be a minimum of 75% Limousin for females and bulls. Lim-flex cattle with a purple registration certificate must be a minimum of 50% for females and bulls. All entries must be sired by a bull that is registered by the North American Limousin Foundation, Limousin and Lim-flex cattle will be shown together. together.

- 1. All yearling bulls must have minimum of 205 days adj. weaning weight of 550 pounds and an average daily gain of 2.6 pounds and a 365 day adj. weight of 1,000 pounds. There is a limit of 50 bulls in the sale.
- 2. Bulls must have been calved before April 15, 2021 and have a minimum 205 day adj. weight of 550 pounds. There is a maximum 105 pound birth weight rule for both sexes.
- 3. Open females calved from August 1, 2021 to April 15, 2021 must be guaranteed by the seller to be bred and to conceive a calf early enough to calve by or before the female is 32 months of age. Bred females born August 1, 2021 must be safe in calf to calve by or before 32 months of age and documented by a veterinarian certificate and guaranteed by the seller. All bred females must sell with specific breeding date or a pasture-exposed date not to exceed 45 days.
- 4. All cattle will sell under the standard guarantee endorsed by the North American Limousin Foundation.
- 5. No adhesive on legs.
- 6. EPD's will be provided to the judge before the show.

From I-90 (heading East or West) take Exit 57, the I-190 Byway heading South and take Exit 1C and proceed to take a left on North Street. At the 4 Way Stop at Mt. Rushmore Road N. If you want to park on the East side of The Monument continue straight at the 4-Way Stop and take a right on to 5th Street, proceed South and The Monument will be on the right.

FROM HWY 79

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

FRIDAY, JANUARY 27 thru SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 4

- 1. All breed entries must be calved after January 1, 2021 and prior to June 1, 2022.
- 2. Original registration papers or proof must be provided at check-in. All cattle entered must be accompanied by a registration number.
- 3. Bulls must be substituted for bulls and heifers must be substituted for heifers, owner for owner for an additional charge of \$35.
- 4. All cattle entering the Show/Sale from outside of South Dakota shall meet the South Dakota Livestock Import requirements, including a current health certificate, permit, individual animal identifications, and certain tests and treatment depends on the state of origin.
- 5. All bulls 13-months and older shall be semen tested within 25 days prior to the Show/Sale and have a satisfactory result declared on the health certificate. All bulls 18-months or older must have a negative trich test per law. Younger bulls only if a virgin must be marked so on the health certificate. (Page 5)
- 6. Screening of all animals is done by a panel under the direction of the BHSS Livestock Committee. Screened animals will not be allowed to enter the sale ring and all entry fees will be forfeited. Screened animals must be immediately removed from the barn by the owner. Any animal not shown will be considered screened. (Page 5)

In order to maintain a high degree of quality at the show, the BHSS reserves the right to screen animals that do not represent the livestock industry, the breed of cattle or the BHSS® in a positive manner.

7. The consignor is responsible for transferring registration of the animal.
