The sale is scheduled for **Friday, January 28<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm** and **Saturday, January 29<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm** at the **James Kjerstad Event Center** at the *Central States Fairgrounds*.

Our market for well seasoned, trained horses has never been stronger. Please give consideration to this select sale when planning your marketing strategy. The Black Hills Stock Show® advertises throughout the country in print, radio, television, social media and internet.

Enclosed is the 2022 Black Hills Stock Show® Horse Sale consignment form. Read the form carefully as there are some changes. Again this year, catalogs will be in full color.

## DEADLINE: MONDAY, NOVEMBER 15<sup>TH</sup> AT 5:00 PM

In order for a consignment to be considered, it must be accompanied by:

1. **Original registration papers:** ALL registration certificates must be in the consignor's name. ***The BLACK HILLS STOCK SHOW® will not accept double transfers!***
2. **Signed transfer** if applicable
3. **Consignment form filled out:** All blemishes ***must*** be noted on the consignment form.
4. **Consignment fee of \$200 per horse,** consignment fee is considered your catalog fee, once your horse is accepted into the sale this fee is non-refundable.

*Consignments will be selected by the Black Hills Stock Show® Horse Sale Committee. The Horse Committee will also select the sale and catalog order. A limited number of consignments will be accepted. The Horse Sale Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any consignment.*

### COMMISSION:

**8% commission** on horses selling up to \$9,999.

**7% commission** on horses selling for \$10,000 and above.

**NO SALES** – All consignors that "No Sale" will be charged a flat fee of \$300. The "No Sale" fee must be paid prior to the horse exiting the sale facility.

## PHOTO TIPS & TRICKS

### PHOTO TIPS & TRICKS

1. Photos are required and help in the selection process plus may help sell your horse, IF IT IS A GOOD PHOTO! Full color photos will be used at the discretion of the Horse Sale Committee but are not guaranteed to be printed in the catalog.

- **Helpful hints:** Horses can be saddled or at halter, but be mindful to have your horse standing square, with ear alert and forward. Try to stand your horse where the background is free of any objects if possible. We accept working shots of horses as well.
- **Horizontal photos work best**
- Full body photos including ears, head, and all four legs

2. All photos submitted with consignments are at the risk and liability of the consignor. The Black Hills Stock Show® shall not be liable for any copyright infringements.

3. Catalog ready photos must be submitted by email to **blackhillsstockshow@gmail.com** at time of deadline (November 15) with horse's name in the subject. It is not the responsibility of the Horse Committee to make sure it is compatible with our system. If submitting photos on a jump drive make sure it is a jpg file and the pictures are clearly marked with the horse's name matching the registration and entry forms.

4. Recommendations for submitting photos:

- Email catalog ready photo to **blackhillsstockshow@gmail.com** – use jpg format, clearly mark the email with the **horse's registered name and consignor's name**. If we can't match the picture to an entry it won't be used.

- First impressions are everything, so only the highest quality, most flattering photos will be used (please see examples on next page).

- Professional quality pictures of the sale horses are encouraged and may be used at the discretion of the Sale Committee in future publications.

# GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

FRIDAY, JANUARY 28 *thru* SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 5

1. BHSS Horse Committee decisions are final.
2. ALL registration certificates must be in the consignor's name by the consignment deadline.  
**The BLACK HILLS STOCK SHOW® will not accept double transfers.**
3. A \$300 withdrawal fee will be charged for any horse that is pulled from the sale without a vet release. This will be strictly enforced.  
**NO SUBSTITUTIONS with other horses!**
4. Check-in time is 11:00 am – 5:00 pm on Thursday, January 27, 2022. ALL HORSES consigned MUST report to check-in (location subject to change) at the west end of the Event Center on the Fairgrounds where they will receive their inspection and hip numbers by the Screening Committee. At the time of check-in, all sale horses must present a  
  
**-Current health certificate (not more than 30 days old)**  
**-Negative Coggins Test (not more than six months old)**  
**-Brand inspection papers**  
  
Horses will be screened by the Screening Committee for but not limited to thriftiness, soundness, disposition and future usefulness.
5. There will be a consignors meeting at 5:15 pm, Thursday, January 27<sup>th</sup> at the Event Center, where hors d'oeuvres and beverages will be served, everyone is welcome to attend.
6. Horses rejected at the screening will not be sold and the consignment fee will not be refunded.
7. Stalls will be available on the Fairgrounds for the sale starting Wednesday, January 26 at no cost.
8. The sale will be held at the James Kjerstad Event Center. Consignor must furnish feed, water and care for horses until the horse(s) are sold. Please make arrangements with buyer for care of the horse after the sale.
9. All horses consigned to the sale must enter the sale ring, unless screened by committee. If the animal does not enter the sale ring, a withdrawal fee of \$300 will automatically be assessed against the animal plus any applicable fees.
10. NO SALES – will be charged a flat fee of \$300.
11. The Black Hills Stock Show® Management, or their Employees will not be responsible for any injury to or loss of any animal or accidents thereby or any injury or loss of life to any participants or spectators during the Stock Show.
12. The Black Hills Stock Show® Horse Sale Committee reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions, or differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of, or connected with or incident to the Sale.
13. Each consignor accepts the responsibility of guaranteeing his own horse(s) to be in sound, healthy condition and has the privilege of giving additional guarantee on his horse(s) at the time of their sale in the Sale Ring. The Black Hills Stock Show® Horse Sale Committee does not act as agent for or represent either the buyer or seller but merely provides an environment for binding together buyer and seller for the purpose of sale transactions. IF an adjustment needs to be made, it must be made between the purchaser and the consignor.
14. All Consignors will be held to the Terms and Conditions of Consignment whether or not you read and/or sign the contract.

The Black Hills Stock Show® is proud to offer a selection of AQHA Ranching Heritage Eligible horses. These horses are raised by ranches that have received the designation of "Ranching Heritage Breeders" by the AQHA, and are eligible to compete in the AQHA Ranching Heritage Challenges across the United States. ## HORSE SALE CHECK-IN REQUIREMENTS:

1. **Health Certificate** – not more than 30 days old (required).

-**Out of state horses** will need to consult with their state of origin to abide by state import regulations. A state permit number will need to be indicated on the health certificate.

2. **Negative Coggins Test** – not more than six months old (required).

3. **Brand Inspection papers**

-Papers are required on branded horses, if you are coming from a no brand area you will have to do an affidavit during check-in

-No branded horses coming from a no brand area do not need anything

Checks will be held after sale until proper paperwork is presented to the Brand Inspector. Any Brand Inspection questions call Walt Brindley (605) 381-3741.

4. **Horses will be screened** at check- in by the Screening Committee for, but not limited to, soundness, disposition, and overall appearance/body condition. Horses rejected at screening will not be sold. The consignment fee will not be refunded.
