No hangers are allowed.

4. All **YOUTH** photos must be 5x7" inch print with an 8x10" inch mat. No larger. All **ADULT** photos must be 8x10" print with an 11x14" inch mat, except for panoramas.

5. All exhibits in this department must be work done by the exhibitor and needs to have been done in the last one (1) year.6. Prints may be displayed in either vertical or horizontal position.

 The name and address of the exhibitor and title of the print must be on the back of the print.

8. Professional photographers are invited to display three (3) entries total.

9. Photographs are judged on composition, technique, impact, focus, lighting and needs to follow that class's description.

CLASS 49 - Color Fair Theme Photo- This photo must be in full color. Exhibitor can shoot any subject, but there may be no photo manipulation. Follow all general rules & use Fair Theme.

NEW FOR 2020 - DRONE PHOTOGRAPHY!

Photo must include drone type, location, altitude photo was taken at, and description on attached 3x5' index card. Any inappropriate or irresponsible photos will be disqualified. **CLASS 50 -** Drone Photography

NEW FOR 2020 - PERSPECTIVE PHOTOGRAPHY

Perspective technique manipulates our human perception with the use of optical illusions to make objects appear larger, smaller, farther, or closer than they actually are. Photo manipulation is allowed for this class.

8th Annual Digital Camera Shootout Photo Contest! "Oink, Moo, Ewe!"

DATE: Friday, August 21, 2020 from 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM **WHO**: The Digital Camera Shootout Contest is available to ages 15 and older. Contest Pre-Registration is required by Thursday, August 20 (contest pre-entry forms are available in the Fair Office).

THEME: All participants will receive the same 2 themes. **WHERE:** Fair Office (located on the backside of the Main Exhibit Building - MEB) - check in at 10:00 AM on Friday, August 21st to get started. You will have until 1:00 PM.

RULES: Contestants must pre-register by Thursday, August 20th by picking up a contest entry form from the Fair Office. Check-In by 10:00 AM on Friday, Aug. 21, and make sure you have your digital camera with you. Upon Check-In, contestants will receive instructions and their two (2) predetermined themes for the contest. Exhibitors will be given 3 HOURS from their check-in time to capture their theme on camera. After three hours, participants must return to the Fair Office to download a total of four (4) images of their choice - two (2) for each theme - from their camera to the Fair Office Computer.

You can enter four (4) photos this year. Two (2) photos are allowed for each of the two themes.

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: Contestants must have their own <u>Digital Cameras</u>, and MUST have a <u>camera cord</u> with a USB connection to plug into a computer to load photos. **NOTE:** Your camera memory card **will not work** to transfer, please bring a USB connecting cord for your digital camera to the Fair Office Computer!

OTHER RULES: Digital alterations and cropping WILL be allowed in 2020. No tripods will be allowed. Tripods can be a trip hazard, so they are not permitted for this contest. All photos will become the property of the Bonner County Fair.

JUDGING & VOTING: Contestants must bring their photos (either on their camera with their USB cord, or on a USB Flash Drive) and return to the Fair Office within three (3) hours of their start time for judging. Photos will be uploaded to the Fair's Facebook page for voting. The public will have the opportunity to vote on Facebook for a five-hour window on Saturday, Aug. 22nd from 10am -3pm, by hitting "LIKE" on the photo that is their favorite. Only one vote will be allowed per person for each theme.
