RULES & REGULATIONS

All livestock ages as of August 1st of current year

Refer to general livestock exhibitor Rules & Regulations. Entry for 4-H and Open Class Goats will be Monday, August 15 from 1pm-4pm. Market Goat Weigh-In is Mon, Aug. 15 4-5pm. 4-H Record Books will be checked on Mon, Aug. 15 from 4-5pm.

1. Entries are open to both purebred and grade stock.
2. Exhibitors must state the breed on their entry form.
3. Exhibitors must furnish their own feed and water containers.
4. No horned goats allowed unless registered breeding stock and goats whose breed or purpose specifies they not be dehorned.
5. No bucks over 6 months old are permitted on the grounds.
6. Meat goats must be dehorned or must be tipped.
7. The decision of the judge is final.
8. All goats must be out of the barn by Sun. Aug. 21 by 12pm.

- All mullets must be grown by the participant themselves, no fake hair, wigs, extensions, or artificial hair will be accepted into the following categories, except for Category 4 (listed below).

CATEGORIES:

1. Men's 18+ Best Mullet
2. Women's 18+ Best Mullet
3. Co-Ed 17 & Under Best Mullet
4. Best Fake Mullet
5. Overall Best Mullet



There will be a winner awarded to each category.

Mullets will be judged on:

- Volume - thickness and fullness of the mullet
- Length - how long in inches your mullet is
- Quality - how close is your hair to the "actual mullet look"
- Style - how the hair is cut and arranged
- Dazzle - does your hair have any unique characteristics
