This department is subject to all Boulder County Fair General Rules and all Open Class Creative Living Rules in addition to those listed for the department. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to be familiar with all rules.

RULES:

1. Read Open Class Creative Living Rules and Boulder County General Rules and Regulations.
2. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placing.
3. Honey Categories - only one entry per person, family or apiary is allowed in each class.
4. A clear one-pound, glass Queenline - type jar - or a clear one-pound, pint glass canning jar are acceptable.
5. Containers should be clean and filled to the threads of the chosen jar.
6. No labels should be placed on the outside of the jars.
7. All frame or section entries must be enclosed in a see-through protective container or wrapped with clear plastic in order to avoid invasion by bees or insect pests.
8. All (creamed or whipped) honey must be in a wide-mouth clear jar.
9. All cut comb honey, square or round, must be in a clear container of appropriate size.

CLASS: HONEY

1. Extracted Liquid Honey---Light
2. Extracted Liquid Honey—Amber
3. Extracted Liquid Honey---Dark
4. Cut Comb Honey suitably wrapped or packaged in a food grade container
5. Full Frame Comb Honey---any size, suitably wrapped or packaged
6. Creamed or whipped Honey -----one wide mouth clear jar.
7. Infused Honey with natural flavorings (is judged as liquid honey)

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placing.
