**RULES:**

1. Exhibitors must read and be familiar with, and comply with, the Boulder County Fair General Rules and Regulations, Open Creative Living General Rules and Regulations, and any applicable division or class rules.
2. Entries must have been produced by the exhibitor.
3. Entries must be **ORIGINAL** works created within the last year.
4. Entries must be creative (that which requires original thinking, planning and doing). No patterns, stereotyped cutouts, hectograph outlines, or coloring books will be allowed.
5. Entries must be picked up between 4:00 and 6:00pm on Monday, August 12. The exhibitor is responsible for collecting their entry or making arrangements to have them picked up.
6. Exhibitors must be in 12<sup>th</sup> grade or younger (school grade refers to grade completed in the spring of fair year).
7. An exhibitor may have only two entries per class.
8. All art work must be matted or mounted and have some means of hanging suitable for display on display boards, not to exceed 20" by 24" including mat or mount. We use push pins, staples, or bulldog clips and hooks to hang artwork on display boards. The fair will not be responsible for damages. Pastels and watercolors may be covered with plastic wrap. **No hard frames or framing with plexi-glass or glass will be allowed.**
9. Entries will be judged on the following: construction, general appearance, degree of difficulty, and originality.

10. The name, address, age, and school grade of the child exhibiting **MUST** be placed on the **BACK** of each entry.
11. Any child 6 and under who is not in first grade may enter Preschool Art.
12. Entries may be assigned to another or new class at the discretion of the judge or superintendent.
