## I. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Complete one of the provided envelopes, so that you may be located in the event of an emergency.
- 2. Place \$3.00 per person in the envelope for each day of your planned visit and put this into the slot in the pipe vault. Maximum length of stay is 14 days. Check-out time is 2:00 P.M.
- 3. You may enter the campground by following the main trail to your campsite, or you may enter by boat from the lakeshore.
- 4. Hiking, bird watching, bank fishing and swimming are allowed in this area at your own risk.
- 5. Water available at a centrally located restroom/shower area only, which includes an Eloo waste system. Call the Park Office for lock combination to restroom/shower facility at 361-782-5456 or after-hours Project Security: 361-782-8013.
