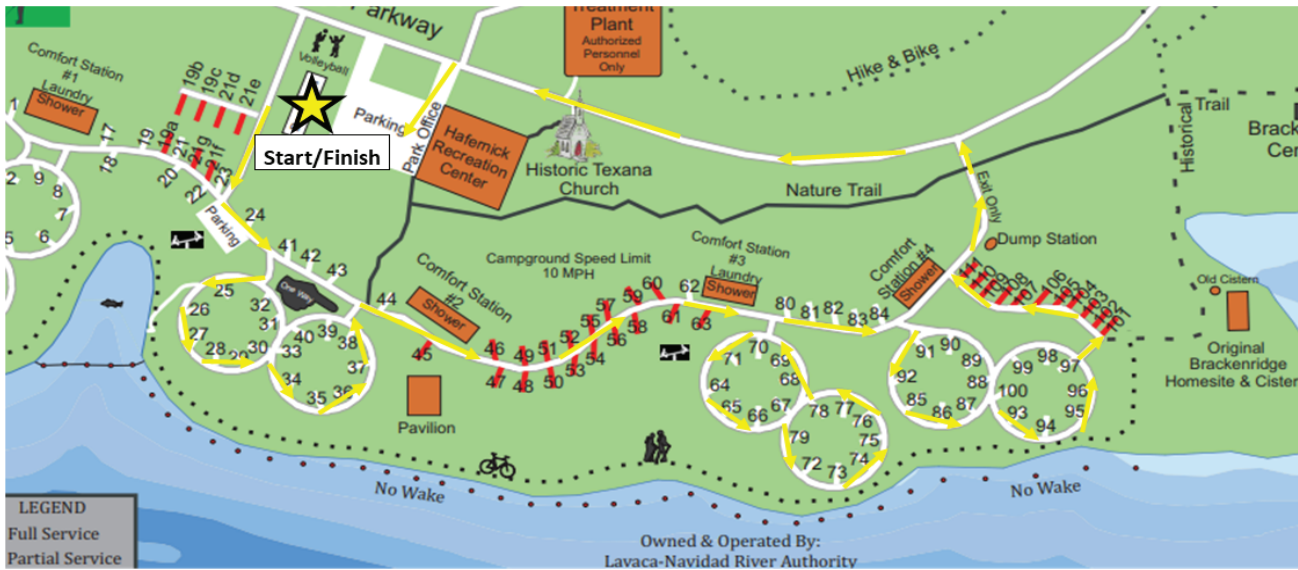

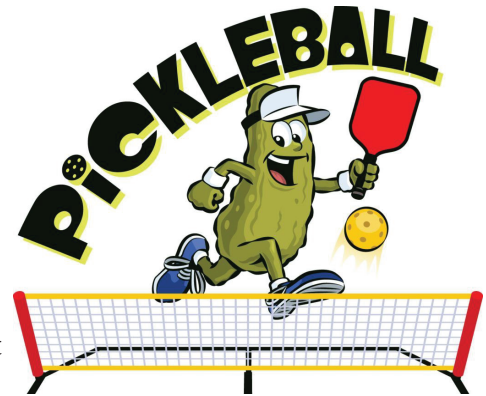
WHAT IS PICKLEBALL?

March 15th: Kiss-N-Kick Barrel Race!

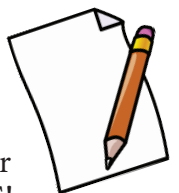
Kiss-N-Kick is back at the MEC for Wednesday night fun! The evening will kick off at 7:30PM and is FREE admission for Spectators!
