



## 2024 BRAZORIA COUNTY CATTLEMEN'S ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

### AMOUNT

\$2,000.00 to be paid to the credit of student's account at the college of his/her choice, over two years.

### ELIGIBILITY

1. A scholarship will be awarded to a deserving student entering a college. If the Scholarship Selection Committee approves no student, this award will not be made for this year.
2. The student must have been a resident of Brazoria County for at least one (1) year before he/she is eligible for the scholarship.
3. The student should be pursuing a career in veterinary medicine or an agricultural related field.
4. The student must be planning to attend a two or four year accredited or approved college or university.
5. Student must pass 12 semester/quarter hours maintaining a 2.0 grade point average or will forfeit scholarship. If the student Q-drops a class and it puts them below 12 hours, the student will be placed on probation and must pass 12 semester hours the following semester.
6. The candidate will be selected on the basis of:
  - a) Scholastic standing,
  - b) Need for financial assistance; and
  - c) Results of personal interview by the Brazoria County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship Committee.
