2024 Brazos Bill's Champion Show Buddy Scholarship

This scholarship will be given to selected outstanding Brazoria County 12th grade students pursuing a career in any field.

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating 12th grade high school student currently enrolled in a state-accredited Brazoria County school. In the event that there are no 12th grade students available to apply for the current year then the scholarship will be available to an 11th grade student.
- 2. Applicant must have been a Brazos Bill's Champion Show buddy.
- 3. Applicant must be planning to attend a 2 or 4 year accredited or approved college or university, or trade school.
- 4. Scholarship payments, to include books, tuition and related fees, will be made to the college, university, or trade school of the winners' choice.
- 5. Selection of the scholarship winner will be made by the BCFA Brazos Bill's Champion Show committee.
- 6. Proof of enrollment for the upcoming semester must be sent to the Brazoria County Fair office before payment will be sent to the school.
- 7. Merit must exist to be awarded a scholarship.
- 8. Applications must be completed and received in the Brazoria County Fair Office, P.O. Box 818, Angleton, Texas 77516 by the date specified on the application.

Application Requirements:

- Essay containing the following:
 - Your experience and what you learned while being a Brazos Bill's Champion Show Buddy.
- Include a recent photo of yourself.
- Include a copy of a current official high school transcript.
- Include two letters of recommendation from a teacher, 4-H leader, Ag Leader/Teacher, Principal, Counselor, or Coach. Please no family members or friends. In addition, ALL letters of recommendation MUST include a heading, title of the person writing the letter of recommendation and contact information must be included.
- Application must be completed and received in the Brazoria County Fair office by the specified date on the application to the attention of <u>BCFA Brazos Bill's Buddy Scholarship c/o Tammi Vasquez</u>.
- Make sure this application has been read in its entirety and all appropriate signatures are presented below.
