Rules

- 1. All entries and awards in this department will comply with General Livestock and Fair Rules printed in this catalog unless otherwise specified.
- 2. This show will be governed by the most current rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
- 3. The show is not responsible in case of fire, accident, theft, or providential destruction. However, every precaution possible will be taken to safeguard the animals exhibited.
- 4. All rabbits must be identified by a legible and permanent ear mark in the left ear before animals are entered into show.
- 5. Substitutions will be allowed in same class, sex, and variety at check-in only. NO CHANGES OR CORRECTIONS WITHOUT COMMITTEE APPROVAL AFTER CHECK IN.
- 6. This is a "CARRYING CAGE SHOW".
- 7. Sex and age classification within breed will be according to the ARBA standards of perfection.
- 8. No does with litters will be allowed in the show room.
- 9. No exhibitor or spectator shall be allowed behind the judging table.
- 10. Absolutely no breeding of rabbits will be allowed.
- 11. All stock must be checked in with the Show Secretary.

- 12. All exhibitors will be responsible for picking up their own comment cards at the completion of the Junior Breeding Rabbit Show. Ribbons will be handed out at the table during the specific breed.
- 13. A. OWNERS OF THE BEST OF BREED AND BEST OPPOSITE SEX MUST LEAVE A REPRESENTATIVE RABBIT OF THE BREED ON DISPLAY DURING THE FAIR. IF CAGE SPACE PERMITS, BEST OF *VARIETY* AND BEST OPPOSITE SEX VARIETY MUST ALSO STAY. Cages will be provided for these animals.
- 13. B. THE EXHIBITOR MUST BRING THEIR OWN WATER CONTAINERS AND BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DAILY FEEDING, WATERING AND CLEAN UP UNDER CAGES OF THEIR ANIMALS. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH DAILY FEEDING, WATERING AND CLEAN UP UNDER CAGES OF ANIMALS WILL RESULT IN EXHIBITOR BEING ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW AND BEING BARRED FROM NEXT YEAR'S RABBIT SHOW.
- 14. All entries must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor at time of entry.
- 15. No pre-junior class will be judged.
- 16. No crossbred rabbits may be shown.
- 17. RABBITS TO BE RELEASED ONLY TO EXHIBITOR. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST OBTAIN RELEASE PAPERS FOR EACH ANIMAL BEFORE LEAVING FAIRGROUNDS.
- 18. Payment vouchers must be cashed in by the last Saturday of the Fair.
- 19. For exhibitor eligibility requirements, see General Livestock Department rules.
- 20. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES OF THIS DEPARTMENT WILL RESULT IN THE EXHIBITOR BEING BARRED FROM SHOWING IN THIS DEPARTMENT THE FOLLOWING YEAR.
