Rules and Information:

1. Entries will be accepted on Saturday, September 9, 2023, 8 am to 10 am at the Brazoria County Fairgrounds Entertainment Hall. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis until all positions are filled. Parent or guardian and child must be present at tie entry is taken.
2. Entry form will not be accepted without acknowledgement of contestant release & indemnity agreement, nonrefundable \$50 entry fee, and a copy of birth certificate to verify age of contestant.
3. "TOP 90" entries are non-refundable.
4. The first 90 entries ("Top 90") will be accepted and the following six (6) entries (two per night) will be classified as alternates.
5. In the event that a "Top 90" entry does not qualify due to weight or inability to ride; the next eligible alternate will move into the "Top 90".
6. Weight limit is 60 lbs. on day of weigh-in. Weigh-in is September 9, 2023, at the Entertainment Hall from 10 am to 12 pm.
7. All entries must weigh-in on September 9, 2023 or will be disqualified from participation.
8. No youth under four (4) years of age or over the age of eight (8). Proof of age (copy of birth certificate which will remain with application) is required. Birth certificate must be provided by parent at time of entry.
9. You must report to the arena by 5:30 pm on Friday, 5:30 pm Saturday night and 12:30 pm Sunday afternoon. A contestant number will be issued at that time and must be worn during the entire event.
10. **Helmets will be provided and are Mandatory. You may bring your own bicycle helmet.**
11. Long Sleeve shirts and pants are required.
12. Only one parent will be allowed in the arena.
13. No ropes or spurs.
