### 2024 BRAZOS VALLEY FAIR & RODEO GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES & APPLICATION

In 2024, the Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo (BVFR) will award three, \$1,500 General Scholarships to outstanding students who are seeking to earn a degree from an accredited college, university, or post-secondary institution. The three scholarships will be awarded to students who qualify through the Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo General Scholarship Application.

The Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo's Educational Programs are a significant part of the BVFR's goals of benefiting youth, supporting education, and facilitating better agricultural understanding. All recipients of BVFR scholarships must demonstrate academic potential, leadership and financial need. Full scholarship will be awarded in the second semester of the recipient's freshman year, after correct documentation is sent to the BVFR office. Any scholarship monies not claimed by the end of five years, post high school graduation will be forfeited by scholarship winner.

May 31, 2024	Scholarship recipients will be notified by this date
October 19, 2024	Scholarship Recipient Presentation during BVFR

#### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a resident of the Brazos Valley
  - Eligible counties include Brazos, Burleson, Grimes, Leon, Madison, Milam, Robertson, and Washington
- Must have been an active participant at the Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo. Those who have volunteered, exhibited or competed are eligible.
- Must attend an accredited college, university, or post-secondary institution and be able to provide required proof of enrollment and completion of courses.
- Applicant must be a confirmed junior or senior in high school in order to qualify for this scholarship and include their most recent report card. BVFR staff will contact the school for verification.
- Applicants must <u>fully type</u> and complete the 2024 Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo Application. Include at least a 300-word, typed, double-spaced essay. The topic for this essay can be found on the main application page.

 Please note if applicant has qualified for more than one scholarship through BVFR programs, no more than <u>\$1750</u> will be paid in one semester, including BVFR livestock scholarships.

### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION EVALUATION

The following items will be weighed by the panel of judges selected by the BVFR to evaluate each applicant in a fair manner. Each application is scored based on the following items:

- Scholastic and academic ability/achievements
- Agricultural activities and achievements, 4-H and FFA
- Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo participation
- Understanding of the agricultural industry as displayed in essay response.
- Interview (If you cannot make this day, please let us know so we can get you an assigned zoom interview.)

## DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

- Application must be postmarked or emailed to the fair staff no later than <u>April 1,</u> <u>2024.</u>
- Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than May 31, 2024.
- An application is not complete until the Brazos Valley Fair & Rodeo Scholarship Department has received the required documents. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted!
