CALIFORNIA RODEO SALINAS DONATES ALMOST \$800,000 TO COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS IN 2024



On September 19, 2024, the California Rodeo Salinas proudly announced a significant contribution of \$796,337.32 to local nonprofits, Western industry groups, and community organizations. This remarkable figure represents a 3.28% increase from last year's donations, which had previously set the record for the highest contribution. Factors contributing to the rise include increased Rodeo attendance, donations to VetTix, increased scholarship funds, and allocating additional volunteer positions to local organizations. The grand total also encompasses reduced rates for facility rentals and the provision of complimentary tickets to further support the community.

Meet Kelly Mata Navarro California Rodeo's Golden Circle Champion 2023-2024

Kelly Mata Navarro is 12 years old and has survived cancer 3 times. She was diagnosed in November 2019 with Ewings Sarcoma on her right femur. Kelly had had a hip replacement; they had to remove her leg bone and replace it with artificial bone with a prosthetic. She finished treatment and had clean scans, but the cancer relapsed in November 2022. Thankfully Kelly won the battle again. Her family is praying that this ugly disease never comes back to their lives.

On Thursday, July 18th the California Rodeo Salinas honored pediatric cancer survivors and raised funds and awareness for the Golden Circle of Champions. Kelly and past champion Olivia released doves during our opening ceremony while two current pediatric patients, Jaizel and Addy, rode in the grand entry.

The Golden Circle of Champions, honors 20 children and their families fighting life-threatening cancer during the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas. While in Las Vegas, the children and their families are honored at the Golden Circle of Champions Banquet at the South Point Hotel, Casino & Spa. The children dine with rodeo champions, receive special gifts and learn about the sport of rodeo and all honorees attend the Wrangler NFR.

To further support the cause, the California Rodeo Salinas organized a drive-thru dinner fundraiser on Thursday, March 7th, 2024. Owner of Salinas City BBQ, Franz Ingram (father of Olivia Ingram, Golden Circle Champion 2022 recipient) partner with the Rodeo, along with Ono Ono Hawaiian, provided meals for up to four people at Rabobank Stadium.
