Whiplash The Cowboy Monkey is truly a fan favorite. He is the world's smallest cowboy, 3-Time Pro Rodeo Entertainer of the Year and an international star who has been putting smiles on faces for years.

Whiplash is a Capuchin Monkey who has been riding since he was two years old. He travels the country herding wild Barbados sheep at rodeos and other events. Whiplash, dressed in his cowboy hat, silk scarf, chaps and Justin Boots, never misses a chance to show his skills and cowboy spirit as he rides his trusty Border Collie mount, Boogie.

Whiplash has entertained crowds at rodeos, ball games and events all across North America and Europe. He has starred in a series of television advertisements for the fast food chain Taco Johns. He has appeared on numerous commercials, ESPN, Good Morning America and The Today Show.

Long-time PRCA card holder, Kenny Petet of Stephenville, Texas, travels with Whiplash the Cowboy Monkey. "He is really more like part of the family, with his big personality and diva-like charm." said Petet

"The rodeo star has his preference, he likes watching TV westerns and playing catch. His favorite snacks are grapes, Oreos and his bed-time peanut butter and jelly sandwich. He is playful and flirts with the ladies, but is serious about his job. There is nothing he loves more than riding his Border Collie, Boogie."

Dusty is the oldest grandson of the long time rodeo clown and entertainer Dick "Old Man" Barrett.

With this heritage, Dusty could not help but begin his rodeo career at a very young age. As soon as he was old enough to walk, Dusty began shadowing his grandfather in the rodeo arena. Traveling up and down the east coast, Dusty helped "Old Man" tell jokes and perform acts.

As a teenager Dusty began riding all three rough stock events (Bareback, Saddle Broncs, and Bull Riding). During this time he stayed true to his roots and continued to clown rodeos during any spare moments that he had.

In 1998 Dusty won the PRCA First Frontier Circuit Saddle Bronc Riding Year End Championship adding this to his many other accomplishments. With this championship he retired from competition to concentrate on clowning full time.

In 1999, Dusty married his long time partner Jennifer. Together they began training horses as well as creating specialty acts for Dusty to take on the road for entertaining. In 2004 He was proudly accepted into the PRCA.

Now with Dusty's animal acts such as his Roman Riding Ponies, Trick Riding Pony, and "Squirt Gun" the trick pony, he is one of the up and coming great specialty performers in Rodeo today.
