D.A.V. National Commander, Dave Riley will make inaugural dives utilizing MBV's "Lift to Freedom" submersible dive platform

Monterey Bay Veterans will be joined by D.A.V. national and state officers, government and non-government veteran service organizations, and local and state dignitaries in dedicating the customized dive boat, Freedom, a one-of-a-kind vessel specifically designed to provide physically challenged divers safe access to scuba diving.

Several days of ocean dives by D.A.V. National Commander Dave Riley, a U.S. Army and U.S. Coast Guard veteran and quadruple amputee, and other challenged divers will culminate with the dedication ceremony on September 27, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. PT.

The vessel Freedom symbolizes the latest program development in Monterey Bay Veterans' continuing effort to provide access to recreational rehabilitation for Monterey County's disabled veterans and the general disabled population.

Freedom's sister ship, Independence, will be available as an observation vessel for dives on the morning of September 27, 2016. Space is limited, so please indicate if you would like to be on the boarding list.
