

prestigious ProRodeo Tour Finale this year! The ProRodeo Tour Finale is a big deal.



Dave Pedrazzi, the California Rodeo's 2020 and 2021 President, loves traditional rodeo events and, being a rancher himself, has selected classic events to be featured on the commemorative posters that he directed. Even though the Rodeo was cancelled in 2020, the poster featured Tie-down Roper Tuf Cooper. Tie-down Roping originated from ranchers doctoring their livestock out in the open. The 2021 poster features the classic rodeo event of Saddle Bronc Riding, originating from cowboys breaking horses to ride. The vibrant oil painting by Marti Miller Hubbell was modeled after a photo of 2014 World Champion Spencer Wright, a member of the well-known Wright family from Milford, Utah, taken by Phil Doyle of Livermore, CA. 



2021 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

The California Rodeo Salinas started its Hall of Fame in 2010 as part of the centennial anniversary of this annual western event. The Rodeo has long been supported by loyal volunteers who work on over 80 committees during the event, personnel, contestants and performers whose talents enhance the show. After 100 years of business it was past time to honor those who helped build the organization and elevate the California Rodeo to one of the top 10 professional rodeos in the United States and the largest in California. The California Rodeo accepts applications each year with inductions taking place every other year.

SALINAS IS THE PRORODEO TOUR FINALE

The California Rodeo Salinas is excited to host the ProRodeo Tour Finale in 2021, the last regular season rodeo of the year. The event will featured the top 24 contestants in each event competing for big money in Salinas with some athletes being catapulted into qualifying for the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in December.

The format will look mostly the same to fans with 16 roughstock contestants competing in Bareback Riding, Saddle Bronc Riding and Bull Riding daily, Thursday, Friday and Saturday and 12 timed event contestants competing in Team Roping, Tie Down Roping, Steer Wrestling and Women's Barrel Racing daily Thursday, Friday and Saturday with a slack session held Saturday 10am to



noon before the performance. This year is also special as Women's Break Away Roping will be featured in the arena for the first time.

The top 8 contestants in each event will return on Sunday, September 26th for the championship short round – a sudden death shoot out. After the top 8 contestants all compete in each event, the top 4 will come back for another shot to win the money and coveted 'Salinas Buckle.'



All the action will be aired live daily on The Cowboy Channel and streamed live on The Cowboy Channel Plus App. For more information, visit cowboychannelplus.com.
