On October 28, 2021 a meeting was held with the Nice committee, Colleen Faber and concerned citizens/patrons of the CAM-PLEX. As requested below is a bulleted list of items that need addressed to bring CAM-PLEX back to the standard that we have come to expect.

Issues:

- Event Preparation CAM-PLEX facilities have not been prepared, setup for events:
 - Energy Capital, Adon Ranch Productions Tuesday Night Barrel Series,
 County Fair,

Thar Ranch Sorting, MJ Productions summer series, Fizz Bomb and numerous

other events.

 Facility Upkeep - -CAM-PLEX facilities are run-down and in some instances not safe for

human/animals.

o East Pavilion – Roll-up door, Dingy Grungy Environment, Lighting,

heating/cooling venting system trash management

o Horse Barns – Water drainage, Stall Door's (latches, door swinging) Asphalt

heaves have caused stall doors not to open, electrical (lighting), security cameras

Equipment - Broken Panels (jagged edges, non-functioning gates) Broken
 Rodeo

Equipment (roping & bucking chutes)

- Wrangler Arena gates, panels, restrooms, drainage
- o Morningside Park Restrooms, racetrack ground
- Morningside Park/Wrangler Event Crows Nest Upkeep, air conditioners, lighting,

sound

o WIFI access for multiple users (very difficult to run operations with the limited

bandwidth)

- Mobile Event Offices 1 has recently been refurbished the rest need work o
 Mobile Crows Nest need refurbished
- Sliding horse door East Pavilion failure
- Mobile Equipment Unmaintained equipment (Tractors, Rakes, Groomers)
 RV Camping maintain grass, gravel roads
- Horse footing
 - Solutions:
 - Event Preparation
- Develop checklist of needs for CAM-PLEX staff and producers to review annually for events, keep on record
- Annually Schedule meeting with event producer to review setup guidelines (arena, equipment needs, personnel)
- Meet with CAM-PLEX and producers within one-week of event Facility Upkeep
- Full audit/inventory

Of all rodeo equipment portable panels, chutes, gates, fixed arena (Wrangler) for any defects that need to be addressed

- Horse Barns replace as needed suggest using slider doors
- Remove asphalt causes slipping hazards, and prevents doors from opening, could address water drainage
 - • Facilities (restrooms, crows nests, concession) develop list of fixes
 - • East Pavilion develop list of fixes
- Reach out to equipment manufacturers (WW, Priefert) would they be willing to sponsor new arena setups
- More gravel parking lots for safe horse environments
- Walking horse paths from stalls to facility

- Screener for dirt preparation
- Mobile Equipment motor grader for maintaining roads/parking areas/snow removal, appropriate tractor for conditions
 - Create task force of CAM-PLEX staff, Land Board Members and Public to conduct audits
 - Develop community list of volunteers to assist in maintenance
 - Have quarterly maintenance days (defined by Task Force)
 - Hire needed employees
