- New Business—NFR Recap: Dan M really enjoyed Taylor Sheridan as the guest speaker. He is the writer for the Yellowstone series television show. Dave B. talked about one of the breakout session with Sister, Crooked River,. High Desert Stampede. How they have a flyer for volunteers on how they do their operations. Dan M. talked about Justine McKee about the book end on the Cowboy Channel Commercials. We can load a lot of tourism in our Rodeo. Brian said he is a videographer and will be more than happy to help if needed. There was a discussion of past history in the Commercials. Lyle commented on the Executive Council meeting at the NFR. Discussed stand-alone events, turnouts, the May through September program turned out not to be very successful and was not

going to be entertained in 2023. Clayton R reported there are 6064 members currently and are shooting for 6350 for a goal, there currently is 771 rodeos registered at this time. Turnouts were 29% BB, 25% BR, 22% SB. There was a \$1000 put up for scholarship for entries. There is a lot of misinformation with the PETA organization. Here is the facts there were 72,000 outs with 362 reported injuries equals .006%. Rough Stock Rodeo School is March 24,25,26th. They are looking for a smarty Bronc which costs approximately \$18,000 looking for donations. Clint brought up a licensed Drone operator Gordon Christenson. Miss Rodeo Oregon made the top 10 at the MRA pageant. She received several scholarships.
