Information and Rules

1 Entry fees are as follows:

Showmanship: Free

Per Head Entry: \$10.00 (by **July 1, 2023)**

\$15.00 (after July 1, 2023)

All pre-entered exhibitors will receive a Cass County Fair Livestock Exhibitor T-Shirt.

- 2. Any and all cattle must have the proper registration papers (if needed). Properpaper work will be turned into the Superintendent upon arrival.
- 3. Only healthy animals will be admitted. All animals may be subject to a health inspection from a state licensed veterinarian and he/she have the authority tohave any animal deemed a health risk and removed from the fairgrounds.
- 4. Open to exhibitors 21 years of age or younger

The show is open to any youth wishing to exhibit, not just those from Cass County

- 5. Cass County Fair will follow the rules set forth by the Missouri State Fair unlessotherwise noted:
 - · Wristbands will not be used for approved animal care and show prep designations, however;
 - · Please remember this is a youth show and 4-H/FFA Code of Ethics are enforced
- 6. This is a youth show; therefore all 4-H and FFA Code of Ethics will be applied and enforced.
- 7. Market Steers must be born on/after January 1, 2022
- 8. Market animals will be shown by weight.
- 9. Market heifers cannot show in the breeding show
- 10. Breeding females will be shown by breed and age

- 11. Cow/Calf pairs will show in their respective breed in the breeding female show. If the cow/calf pair is chosen as breed champion, they will be brought back in forthe champion drive to represent their respective breed.
 - a. A calf that is part of a cow/calf pair cannot be shown in a heifer calf classand then compete in the cow/calf pair class.
- 12. All cattle will be released at the completion of the show
- 13. Classes may be combined at the discretion of the superintendent
- 14. Single Entry breeds will be shown individually and will be called back in for the Champion Drive for their respective breed. See below for premium schedule.
- 15. Class 100 will have no individual placing. Ribbon color determines payout: \$10(Blue), \$8(Red), \$6(White)
- 16. Livestock exhibitors must be on hand to show their livestock. If the exhibitor hasmore than one animal in the same class another youth may exhibit their animal.
- 17. Limited electricity is available, generators welcome
- 18. Stalling animals in the provided area (barn/tent) is suggested for exhibition purposes, but will not be required due to limited space.
- 19. Bedding will not be supplied
- 20. Please remove all bedding at the completion of the show
- 21. All stalls must be cleaned before being released by the Superintendent
