Information and Rules

1. Entry Fees are: \$10.00 per exhibitor by July 1, 2023 must be entered by July 1 for exhibitor t-shirt \$15.00 per exhibitor after July 1, 2023
2. **All equines must have a current Coggins test to be on the grounds.**
3. This is a youth show therefore 4-H and FFA Code of Ethics will be followed. Kind and humane treatment is a requirement of all exhibitors of their animals. Remember at all times that you are exhibiting in a public environment, excessive use of reins, lead shanks, crops, spurs or hands will result in disqualification.
4. The show Superintendents, workers, Cass County Fair officials or sponsors are not responsible for injuries, deaths, or losses.
5. All Classes are open to Horses, Mules or Donkeys.
6. Horses may not cross enter Saddle Type and Stock Type classes. Saddle Type include Welsh, Arabian, Tennessee Walking Horse, Foxtrotter, gaited, Saddlebred and their crosses. Stock Type includes Quarter types, APHA, Appaloosa or stock type horses.
7. All judge's and superintendent's decisions are final.
8. No Refunds!
9. Boots are required, long pants covering the boots and an exhibitor t-shirt are acceptable. If you did not pre-enter in time for a fair t-shirt you can wear a plain t-shirt. No spaghetti straps, tank tops, or shorts.
10. ** Indicates a Novice rider and they may only enter Novice walk trot classes only.
11. *open class does not have to be Novice to show.
12. High Point Awards for Mule or Donkey, Novice, 12 & under, 13 & over there are also awards given for those with remarkable sportsmanship and horsemanship skills. Our focus is on a fun environment where youth can enjoy competing but not stress or worry over awards, the goal is to have a great time with your horses and friends.
13. AQHA & US Equestrian rules apply, gaited breeds are governed by their individual breed associations.
14. Ranch Pleasure is a rail class with possible technical rail maneuvers at will of the judge. Horses and riders may enter both western pleasure and ranch.
15. Adults may assist exhibitors but are not allowed to ride or train horses at the show.
16. **ASTM-SEI Helmets are required for classes 25-38. No running in and out of the arena for running events.**
