Information and Rules

1 Entry fees are as follows:

Showmanship: Free

Per Head Entry: \$5.00 (by July 1, 2023)

\$10.00 (after July 1, 2023)

- 2. All market lambs must be sheared at the time of arrival at the fairgrounds
- 3. In accordance with the Missouri Department of Agriculture and the Missouri State Fair health guidelines, all sheep (including wethers) must have a Certificateof Veterinary Inspection (health certificate) to be eligible to show. This health certificate must have been written with thirty (30) days of exhibition. All sheep must also be identified either by ear tag, electronic implant, or tattoo.
- 4. Only healthy animals will be admitted. All animals may be subject to a health inspection from a state licensed veterinarian and he/she have the authority tohave any animal deemed a health risk and removed from the fairgrounds.
- 5. Open to exhibitors 21 years of age or younger

- 6. Cass County Fair will follow the rules set forth by the Missouri State Fair unlessotherwise noted:
 - Wrist bands will not be used for approved animal care and show prepdesignations
 - · Please remember this is a youth show and 4-H/FFA Code of Ethics areenforced
- 7. This is a youth show; therefore all 4-H and FFA Code of Ethics will be applied and enforced.
- 8. Market Lambs must be born on/after January 1, 2023
- 9. All Sheep will be released at the completion of the show
- 10. Muzzles will not be allowed on sheep

- 11. Classes may be combined at the discretion of the superintendent
- 12. Single Entry breeds will be shown individually and will be called back in for the Champion Drive for their respective breed. See below for premium schedule.
- 13. Limited electricity is available, generators welcome
- 14. Stalling animals in the provided area (barn/tent) is suggested for exhibition purposes, but will not be required
- 15. Bedding will not be supplied
- 16. Please remove all bedding at the completion of the show
- 17. All stalls must be cleaned before being released by the Superintendent
