It's time for the Cass County Fair Parade! We look forward to your parade entry!
No plaques will be awarded but we will still have the following entries along with their line-up locations:

- Antique Vehicles (Line-up at High School parking lot)
- Floats, commercial and personal (family) (Line-up at High School parking lot)
- Riding Horses (Line-up at Parks & Rec Complex on Broadway)
- Driving Horses (Line-up at Parks & Rec Complex on Broadway)
- Farm Machinery (Line-up at Parks & Rec Complex on Broadway)
- Church (Line-up at High School parking lot)
- Civic Organization (Line-up at High School parking lot)
- Commercial (Line-up at High School parking lot)

The following groups will be lining up as follows:

- Parade Royalty (Masonic Lodge)
- Grand Marshall (Masonic Lodge)
- Emergency Vehicles (Masonic Lodge)

PLEASE NOTE!! This year there will be one place to come in once you have arrived for line-up. Previous entry locations will be completely unavailable.

REMEMBER: first come, first served. Your entry number will be based upon the time of your arrival and entrants will not be separated out, but placed in designated rows by a Parade Volunteer.

PARADE ROUTE

The parade route will start at the intersection of Rooster Way and Broadway Street. Line-up will start in the Pleasant Hill High School parking lot at Rooster Way. The procession will head west on Broadway, cross 7 Hwy, north (right) on Independence, west (left) on Cedar Street, south (left) on Veteran's Pkwy and west (right) on Paul Street in front of the gazebo. Once your group has passed the gazebo you may exit the parade.

PARADE TIMELINE

Parade line-up will begin at 7:45-8:00 AM at the Pleasant Hill High School (east on Myrtle from 7 Highway, then follow the signs).

JUDGING

No entrants will be allowed after 8:30 AM. Entries are not judged but placed in categories.

The parade begins at **9:00 AM**.

PARADE RULES

First and foremost, HAVE FUN. Entries involving children under the age of 17 must be properly supervised by an adult(s).

Our goal is to create a fun and safe event for everyone who participates in the parade, exhibitors and spectators alike! Please review the parade rules prior to submitting your parade entry.

- Once you enter the line-of-march, that is your position in the parade, so please stay in place.
- Please show proper courtesy to all parties involved in the parade.
- All animals in parade must be under control or will be asked to leave.
- All drivers of floats or vehicles shall possess a valid driver's license. Reckless or negligent driving is not allowed.
- Gasoline may not be carried on any vehicle participating in the parade.
- Please remember to bring water to drink!
- The exhibitor will hold harmless the Cass County Fair Board and the City of Pleasant Hill for any accidents or injuries that may occur.
- Parade officials will inspect all entries and reserve the right to eliminate any entry that is in violation of these rules. Changes in the parade line-up will be at the sole discretion of the parade officials.
