Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

#### **Purpose of Form**

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

• Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding, later.

#### State Championship Rules

- Be prepared to show your current health certificate at check-in if you are stalling on site.
- No tying to trailers overnight No portable pens. HORSES MUST BE STALLED OVERNIGHT.
- . Absolutely NO tying horses in the Event Center.
- There will be NO substitution of riders. Horses may be substituted on a VET release only.
- Any form of harassment of officials or unsportsmanlike conduct may be grounds for disqualification.
- Refunds will be subject to review. In cases of family emergencies and other circumstances beyond your control a refund of stall, camping and the entry fee may be possible. We will not be refunding arena or awards fees.

#### Release of Liability

Warning - Under South Dakota law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Section 42-11-2.

By entering the competition, the owner and/or contestant, hereby release and agree to hold harmless, the show committee, all members of the show management and NBHA from any liability for damages or loss, if any suffered or sustained by the owner, exhibitor or handler of such entries as the result of personal injury or property damage occurring in connection with or during the show.

#### Warm-up Sessions:

Numbers will be limited - tickets on a first come, first served basis

Friday: 9:00 am - 11:00 pm: Six (6) 20 min warm-up sessions - (12 tickets/session - \$25/horse)

11:00 am - 2:00 pm: One-time through exhibitions - 50 second time limit - \$5 at the gate

Saturday: Availability of exhibitions will depend on the start time - 50 second time limit - \$5 at the gate

Warm-up Sessions are by a time block – when the time is up, tickets are void. <u>NO REFUNDS</u>. We will offer  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the sessions on a pre-buy basis on Thursday May  $25^{th}$ . The remainder will be available on site only.

- Open Division: Awards will be on the 5D format to 4 places.
  - o Payout: NBHA 5D Format
  - Wildcards will be issued to the Average Winners.
- Youth & Senior Divisions: Awards will be in the 4D format to 4 places.
  - o Payout: NBHA 4D Format.
  - Wildcards will be issued to the Average Winners.
- Pee-Wee division will run each day and will receive an award each day.
- > Pay-out will be 90% of the entry fee +100% added money split between the 2 go's.
  - Added money will be applied equally to each D
- Each contestant will receive 1 event program.
  - Additional programs will be available to purchase at check-in and throughout the finals.
- Make sure you are ready to go when called. If you know you might have gate issues, please tell us, we can make sure someone is there to help you into the arena.
- You will have room to circle your horse in the holding pen. If you choose to circle in the arena One circle only, under continual forward motion. We know everyone wants to make the best run possible; however, please keep in mind the number of horses that have yet to run behind you and help us keep the show moving along.
- Slow down when you enter the alley at the completion of your run. Please show some courtesy to the other contestants in the holding pen and volunteers. Get control of your horse before you hit the end of the alley.
- > The holding pen will be kept in condition with every big rake of the main arena.

#### Dogs must be leashed at all times.
