- 1. Charolais breed is limited to 65 head; limited to 50 bulls and three entries per consignor, two of which may be bulls. Consignor is to designate preference and alternate.
- 2. No adhesive is allowed in the halter show.
- 3. In order to improve the quality of cattle at the show, the State Association Promotion Committee recommends the following guidelines for Charolais Cattle:
 - Bulls need yearling weights of 1,050 lbs.
 - After one year, bulls must gain fifty (50) pounds per month.
 - · Heifers need yearling weights of 750 lbs.
 - Bred heifers should weigh 1,000lbs
