**Exhibits Dismissed:** Sunday of the fair from 6 - 7 p.m. **Items not picked up by 7 p.m. will become the property of the Central Wisconsin State Fair.**

**• AMATEUR ONLY – An amateur makes less than 30% of their income from Photography.**

- All articles must be the work of the exhibitor and not previously exhibited at this fair.
- Exhibitors are allowed only one entry under any lot number; one item per person, per lot number.
- Articles entered in collections cannot compete for separate premiums.
- Each entry must be a unique image. The same image may NOT be enlarged and entered in a different class or lot.

**Character Study:**

Photograph captures distinctive features of a person so that when you look at the photo you see into the depth of the qualities that make him or her unique and/or extremely interesting. Magnifying the distinctive characteristics is important in a character study.

**Portraits, glamour shots, snap shots, and good close-ups of people are not character studies, unless they show effort to study and capture a unique quality of the subject.**

**Still Life:** Photo of inanimate objects (such as fruit, flowers, collectibles, etc.) arranged in an artistic, creative, or interesting manner.

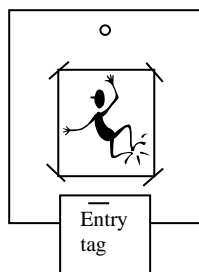
**Human Interest:** Photo that draws out an emotional response or raises curiosity and impacts the viewer.

A Best of Show and Honorable Mention ribbon will be awarded in Class 1, 2, and 3 (No Premium).

**CLASS 1 – AMATEUR ONLY– 4” x 6” & UNDER**

- Photographs must be mounted on 6” x 8” tag board or poster board (no construction paper) making slits in tag board for photo corners. See diagram below. **Rubber cement, photo glue, or tape may be used to hold photo in place along with corner slits.**
- No glass, no wood, plastic or metal frames, or tape.
- Photography only.

Make slits in tag board and insert photo in slits. Punch a hole in tag board for hanging. (Rubber cement or photo glue may be used to hold photo in place.) Staple entry tag to tag board or poster board. (No string needed for hanging.)

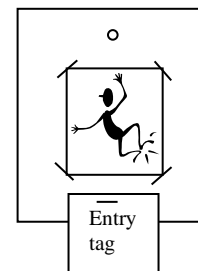

**CLASS 2 – AMATEUR ONLY - ENLARGED**

**Enlargements must be either a 5” x 7” displayed on 8 1/2” x 11” tag board or poster board or an 8” x 10” displayed on 11” x 14” tag board or poster board. No matting or framing of photos.**

- Photographs must be mounted on tag board or poster board (no construction paper) making slits in tag board for photo corners and equipped for hanging. Staple entry tag to poster board. See diagram below. **Rubber cement or photo glue may be used to hold photo in place.** You may use photo splits.
- No glass, no wood, plastic or metal frames, or tape.
- Photography only.

Make slits in tag board and insert photo in slits. Punch a hole in tag board for hanging. (Rubber cement or photo glue may be used to hold photo in place.) Staple entry tag to tag board or poster board. (No string needed for hanging.)

- No glass, no wood, plastic or metal frames, or tape.
- Photography only.

##### Lot

1. Best Collection of Photography 4 to 8 snapshots displayed on no larger than 14” x 22” tag board or poster board (no construction paper).

3. Panoramic Enlarged Photo displayed on heavy poster board, any size, using rubber cement or photo glue. Splicing is also acceptable.
