CLASS A: GRADE 3

(Explorers, Bear or Webelos, Brownie or Junior)

RULES:

- Open to members of recognized organizations in grade 3.
- Project members may enter up to 6 lots, 2 of which may be animals.
- All members must be present for judging.
- All posters, pictures and mounted collections should be **14" x 22" or smaller**. Attach entry tag to upper right corner (hole punched).
- All exhibits must be made by the exhibitor (kits are acceptable).

Lot

Animal Science

1. Display or poster on care of an animal or pet
2. Animal scrapbook – pictures and stories of dogs, horses, cats or other animals
3. Any other animal science project

Plants & Soil Science

4. Vegetable garden box, 2 of each of 3 different vegetables
5. Vegetable plate, 1 of the following: squash, pumpkin, melon or eggplant.
6. Vegetable plate, 2 each of the same vegetable: choose from potatoes, tomatoes (stem on), cucumbers OR carrots (tops cut to 1-2").

7. Potted plant, started by exhibitor from leaf or stem cutting
8. Simple floral arrangement in a vase

Natural and Mechanical Sciences

9. Insects: 10 insects in collection, properly named
10. Birds: scrapbook of 10 bird pictures, properly named
11. Wildflowers: 6 wildflowers, mounted and named
12. Trees: leaves from 6 trees mounted and named
13. Collection of 6 edible seeds, mounted & named
14. Simple model; maximum size of 12"x12"x12"
15. Poster or display on ATV, snowmobile or lawnmower safety
16. Simple electromagnet
17. Any woodworking item made by the exhibitor
18. Any other Natural & Mechanical Science project

Cultural & Communication Arts

19. Simple drawing or painting (must be original)
20. Holiday decoration—handmade
21. Simple leather craft project
22. Simple basket
23. Simple ceramic article (no plaster craft)
24. Creature created from stones
25. Simple potholder—woven
26. Scrapbook pages—1 page (2 sides), any subject
27. Three photographs on different subjects (buildings, people, animals or landscape); mount on 14"x11" poster board
28. Two photos on same subject, one candid shot and one portrait; mount on 10"x12" poster board
29. One candid shot; mount on 6"x8" poster board
30. Story or poem about 4-H or other youth group
31. Any other Cultural Arts project

Computers

32. Greeting card or party invite, computer generated
33. Sign, 8 1/2" x 11", computer generated

Home & Family

34. Brownies, no frosting, no nuts (plate of 3)
35. Chocolate chip cookies, no nuts (plate of 3)
36. Poster or display of items needed to make my favorite food (indicate the food and label items)
37. Simple sewn pot holder

38. Simple sewn article for self; scarf, headband, etc.
39. Simple pot holder—knit or crocheted
40. Simple knit/crochet article for self: scarf, headband, etc.
41. Simple latch hook pillow or wall hanging
42. Any stenciled item for the home
43. Any creative stitchery item
44. Poster or display of your responsibilities around the home
45. Poster or display on home safety hazards and solutions

Health & Citizenship

46. Poster comparing junk foods and nutritious snacks
47. First Aid Kit for use in the house, in durable container with minimum of 6 items
48. Poster or scrapbook on safety in the home, on the farm, etc.

Explorers showing animals will be judged with their animal group on the specified show day. They are allowed to take up to two different species of animals 1 lot each plus a showmanship in each department.

Dept. 1 Dairy: 1 lot number plus showmanship

Dept. 2 Beef: 1 lot number plus showmanship

Dept. 3 Swine: 1 lot number plus showmanship

Dept. 4 Sheep: 1 lot number plus showmanship

Dept 5 Dairy Goats: 1 lot number plus showmanship

Dept. 6 Horse: 1 lot number plus showmanship, costume and gymkhana

Dept. 7 Poultry: 1 lot number plus showmanship

Dept. 8 Rabbits: 1 lot number plus showmanship

Dept. 9 Dogs: 1 lot number plus showmanship

Dept. 10 Animal Science, Small Animals (birds, cavies & any other animal): 1 lot number Dept. 11 Exotic Animals: 1 lot number plus showmanship

CLASS B: GRADES K-2

(Cloverbud, Tiger or Wolf, Daisy or Brownie)

- Project members may exhibit up to 4 items.
- All members must be present for judging.
- All posters, pictures and mounted collections should be **14" x 22" or smaller**. Attach entry tag to upper right corner (hole punched).
- All exhibits must be made by the exhibitor (kits are acceptable).

Animal Science

1. Scrapbook of 5 birds or animals pictures from magazine and labeled
2. Poster or scrapbook page (1) describing a pet or favorite animal, include pictures, drawings, and/or written story
3. Any other Animal Science exhibit

Natural and Mechanical Science

4. One (1) fruit or vegetable raised by exhibitor
5. Potted plant grown from seed
6. Collection of 5 seeds, labeled
7. Collection of 5 rocks, labeled
8. Collection of 5 insects, labeled
9. Simple model put together by exhibitor (wood, plastic, Lego, etc.) *Max. size 12" x 12" x 12"
10. Poster on items a magnet will/will not pick up
11. Any other Natural or Mechanical Science exhibit

13. Simple needlecraft or stitchery item
