Pullorum testing for all birds is <u>REQUIRED</u>. For testing contact Gordie Sternweis (715-387-6602 or <u>gs11502@aol.com</u>) or Josh Sabo (715-676-3123 or <u>ibsabo18@gmail.com</u>). There is a fee for pullorum testing. All testing must be complete <u>PRIOR</u> to entering the fairgrounds. Arrange for testing at least two weeks before the fair (in June to early August).

Birds will be fed and watered by Poultry Department Staff. Exhibition coops, feed and bedding are furnished.

Birds will be released beginning at 2:00pm on Thursday and MUST BE OUT BY 5:00 pm.

Each coop must be identified with the following information on a 4 x 6 card: bird breed, sex & age.

Birds shown in Junior Fairy cannot be shown in Open Class.
