## **Campground Information, Rules & Regulations**

- Vehicle and camping parking passes must be properly displayed at all times.
- Any vehicle/camper parked outside of their assigned campsite will be towed at the expense of the owner.
- Campsites are assigned according to power availability and length of reservation requested. You will receive passes confirming the length of your reservation, as well as a map indicating your campsite location and which power outlet you should plug in to. If you need to make any changes or have concerns, please contact the fair office as soon as possible.
- Quiet hours are from 10:00pm until 7:00am. Noise shall not emit past your assigned camping area during these hours.
- No alcohol is allowed on the campground.
- No fireworks are allowed on the campground.
- Campfires and grills are not allowed.
- Generators are not allowed on the campground.
- Dogs and cats are not permitted on the campground.
- Persons under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to camp overnight. A permission form may be obtained from the fair office for persons under 18 years of age wishing to camp without a parent or guardian present.
- It shall be within the authority of the Fairgrounds Staff, or their representatives, to remove from the grounds any or all members of a group whose behavior, at any time, conflicts with County or State laws; becomes detrimental to the health and safety of the group or other campers/fairgoers; or becomes so unruly as to affect the reasonable enjoyment of the grounds by others.
