Discuss, Consider & Possible Action on Resolution #2022-65 Authorizing the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Gonzales County and the City of Gonzales

### **TYPE AGENDA ITEM:**

### **BACKGROUND:**

Gonzales County has received ARPA funds and desires to distribute those funds within County's local jurisdiction for the purchase of mobile radios. This will provide the opportunity to bring the Police and Fire Department's up to date to expand their communication abilities to be able utilize current radio frequencies that are being utilized by surrounding jurisdictions as well as the local jurisdiction.

The interlocal will be funded in two phases. Phase I will be funding for portable radios, and Phase II will be for mobile radios.

### **POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This is consistent with what has been done in the past.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The interlocal will be funded in two phases which are broken down below:

Police Department: Phase I \$ **19,306.71** and Phase II \$ **117,366.50**

Fire Department: Phase I \$ **54,768.96** and Phase II \$ **13,113.00.**

The Police Department budgeted \$136,674.00 in GL account 100-7-501.609 and the Fire Department budgeted \$67,881.96 in GL 100-7-301.609. Once the expenditure is made the city will be reimbursed by the County for the funds as described in the exhibits.

### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff respectfully recommends the council take the action they deem necessary.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-65**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GONZALES, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN GONZALES COUNTY AND THE CITY OF GONZALES; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, as amended, titled Interlocal Cooperation Contracts, authorizes contracts between political subdivisions for the performance of governmental functions and services; and,

**WHEREAS**, County and City desire to utilize the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”) funds currently available for the purchase of portable and mobile radios for the Gonzales Police Department and the Gonzales Fire Department (“Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is necessary for the benefit of the public, is in the best interest of each Party and the funding fairly compensates the County for the Project performed under this Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GONZALES, TEXAS:**

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Gonzales hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Gonzales County and the City of Gonzales as attached in Exhibits A and B.

Section 2. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the City Council.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.
