# **MINUTES**

#### Call to Order and Certification of a Quorum

Vicki Frenzel called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. A quorum was present.

### **Approval of Minutes**

1. Approval of February 6, 2019 minutes was motioned by Swann Reid, seconded by Martha Jo Whitt, and passed unanimously.

### Items for consideration and possible action

- 2. Discuss, consider, and possible action regarding the president's report:
- \* Library storage of original bound volumes of the Gonzales Inquirer: Vicki Frenzel had nothing to report.
- \* DuBose Collection cabinet lighting: Vicki reminded the Board that the cabinet lighting has a short in it and needs to be replaced. John Tinsley stated that the lights have been purchased and will be installed when possible.
- \* Library memorial to past librarians: Vicki Frenzel stated that it would be nice to hang a plaque in the library acknowledging all the past librarians that have served Gonzales. This was discussed and will require some research.

- \* Accepting ownership of the Bushong Collection and agreement to comply with the requirements of the trust being maintaining insurance on the collection and keeping the collection on permanent display: After discussion, the Board decided to request information before taking action, i.e. taking a look at the agreement.
- 3. Discuss, consider, and possible action regarding the report of librarian:
- \* Report on new library roof: Caroline Helms reported that the bidding process is moving forward with a pre-bid conference scheduled for April 18, 2019.
- \* Mold / Relative Humidity in the Mary Elizabeth Tinsley Texas History Center: Caroline Helms reported that on March 11, 2019 there was mold discovered on 5 books in the Texas Center. At that time the Relative Humidity registered at 58%. The 5 books, on Texas Genealogy, were disposed of, a dehumidifier has been installed, and library staff is watching the RH closely.
- \* Therapy dog reading program through the Dog Alliance: Caroline Helms reported that the library has partnered with a local family to bring in a certified therapy dog for children to read to.
- \* Monthly reports with the addition of the Texas Center gate count: Caroline Helms distributed the monthly reports for February and March 2019, both are attached. She stated that a people counter has been installed in the Texas Center and that gate count has been added to the monthly report.
- 4. Discuss, consider, and possible action regarding the financial report for March 31, 2019: Noell Ince distributed the report, it is attached.
- 5. Next regular meeting will be May 1, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.
