These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the City of Gonzales.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about 6/23/26, the City of Gonzales will submit a request to the Texas Department of Agriculture (Department), Office of Rural Affairs for the release of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Section 104(f) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended, to undertake a project known as 2025 CDBG City of Gonzales Drainage Improvements Project #CDV25-0105 for the purpose of mitigating future flooding with drainage improvements.

Project Location: North Avenue corridor, City of Gonzales, Gonzales County, TX

Description of the Proposed Project: North Avenue: Excavate One (1) stormwater detention pond; install outlet structure. North Avenue Area: Install 540 LF of curb and gutter; install 2,110 LF of 18-inch, 36-inch and 48-inch culverts; install 7 curb inlets; complete replated pavement repair; install concrete headwall; install concrete junction box; and complete associated appurtenances to include administration and engineering services and fees.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The City of Gonzales certifies to the Texas Department of Agriculture, Office of Rural Affairs that Isaac Anzaldua, in his capacity as Mayor, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The Department's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the City of Gonzales to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

The Texas Department of Agriculture will accept objections to its release of funds and the City of Gonzales' certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request, (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the City of Gonzales (b) the City of Gonzales has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the Department; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to Environmental Review Specialist, Texas Department of Agriculture by email at CDBG_ENVReview@TexasAgriculture.gov. Potential objectors should contact the TDA Environmental Review Specialist at CDBG_ENVReview@TexasAgriculture.gov to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
