HEALTH RULES:

As set forth in Florida Livestock Health Regulation and Requirements Section 5C-4.005. Health papers for show and/or exhibit goats will be inspected upon arrival.

GOATS:

All goats six months of age or older consigned for public exhibition in Florida must be covered by an Official Health Certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian certifying the animals to be free from symptoms of contagious or infectious diseases. All goats must be participating in the Scrapies Eradication Program; all tattoos, microchips & ear tag numbers must correspond with the Scrapie Number. Goats less than six months must be accompanied by the health certified doe or be on health certificate.

ELIGIBILITY:

The Dairy Goat Show is open to Youth only. There will also be a Youth Showmanship Contest that will be divided into a Junior Division (Age 8-10), Intermediate Division (Age 11-13) and a Senior Division (Age 14-18). To enter showmanship, all showman must be entered in and participate in the Open Dairy Goat Show.

GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS:

1. All Animals must be dehorned or naturally hornless, small scurs will be accepted based on superintendents judgement. If in doubt about horns/scurs contact BEFORE Aimee Huskey before show.
2. Any type of collars with prongs or any type with sharp elements ARE NOT ALLOWED.
3. All entires are subject to Superintendent's decision.
4. Exhibitors must provide their own feed, feed containers, water containers and bedding.
5. All exhibitors must clean up their area/pen before leaving, failure to do so will result in loss of premium money.

6. Due to the large number of show animals entering the Fairgrounds on the date of the show, dairy goats must arrive for the show between 7:00 a.m. to 8:45 a.m., April 1, 2023. Please arrive before 8:45 a.m. as to be ready at 10:00 a.m. for show. All dairy goats must be thru health inspection by 9:00 a.m... **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
7. Goats participating in the show must be checked in before 9:30am on Saturday, April 1, 2023. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 8.. Decisions regarding show animals remain with the Dairy Goat Superintendent.

ENTRIES:

Pre-Entries are required. Entry fee is \$5.00 per animal and showmanship is included in animal entry. Pre-Entry Deadline is March 17, 2023. Each person showing a goat must be registered and have a number. Each person entered may show one goat in each class. The show is limited to the first 130 goats registered. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.** If you do not get an entry confirmation, email you need to contact the Clay County Fair Office or you will not be eligible to show.

ENTRY FEE:

\$5.00 per animal.

Deadline for entries is March 17, 2023. Limited to the first 130 goats registered. Absolutely no changes or substitutions allowed on day of show unless a junior is to be moved to a senior doe class.

CLASSES:

Junior Doe Classes

J1 – 6 months and under

J2 – 6-12 months

J3 – 12 – 18 months

J4 – 18-24 months

Grand and Reserve - all 1st and 2nd place Jr Does

Senior Doe Classes (does who have freshened)

S1 – Under 12 months of age

S2 – under 2 years of age

S3 – over 2 years of age & under 4 years

S4 – over 4 years of age

Grand and Reserve - all 1st and 2nd place Sr. Does

Pet Wether Show

W-1 Wethers 6 months and under

W-2 Wethers 6 months and older

There will be no Grand or Reserve placing in the pet wether class.

*Place your animal in the proper class based upon their age on the DAY OF SHOW. April 1, 2023.

Pee Wee Exhibition: This class is open to any child 7 years of age and under showing any doe or wether they choose. They may have help from any one person they choose to help them in the ring. They will receive a ribbon for participation. Premium money will be not awarded. This is the only class that can register on the day of show.

Showmanship:

Junior Showmanship: 8 - 10 years of age

Intermediate Showmanship 11-13 tears of age

Senior Youth Showmanship: 14 - 18 years of age

*Showmanship classes may be split based on number of entrants in class

JUDGING:

1. The Modified Danish System of Judging will be used for the Goat Classes. 2. Goats will be judged on conformation and Dairy characteristics.
2. Youth Showmanship will be judged on the ability of the exhibitor to properly show the goat, fitting, and questions.
3. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Dairy Goats will be selected from Jr. Doe and Sr, Doe class first and second place goats.
4. Judge’s decision is final.

AWARDS: ALL AWARD MONEY MUST BE PICKED UP BY 1 hour after conclusion of show ON DAY OF SHOW OR IT WILL BE FORFEITED.
