***Fair entry tickets for participants will be available at the Clay 4-H Office one week prior to the first day of the fair. No tickets will be given out at the fair gates. ***

Description:

This is a fun show open to all youth 5-18 years of age. Rabbits are to be dressed in creative and safe fashions. Participant costumes optional.

Age Divisions:

Pee-Wee: ages 5-7

Juniors: ages 8-10

Intermediates: ages 11-13

Senior: ages 14-18

Application:

Applications are due on or before March 17, 2023

Entries are limited to the first 30 completed applications.

Rules:

1. All rabbits must pass inspection which is held between 12:00 – 12:30pm, including the rabbits showing in the Fair Rabbit Show. NO exceptions.
2. NO entries will be accepted at the show
3. Youth can only show one rabbit
4. Except for the Pee-Wee division, no persons are allowed to help youth set up the rabbits during the competitions. In the Pee-Wee division, persons may help the youth bring the rabbit to and from the show table
5. Clothes/costumes may not contain glue or pins that could harm rabbit. Cannot shave, dye or glue the rabbit's natural fur and NO PIERCINGS.
6. Judge's rule is final
7. Rabbits are not permitted in designated eating areas, i.e. picnic tables, concessions, etc.
8. Rabbits are to exit the fair after the show is complete. (Exceptions: rabbits entered in the Fair Rabbit Show must go back to their pens.)
9. **Monies not picked up at show will be forfeited back to the Clay County Fair Association.**

Individual Awards

All rabbits will be judged following the Danish system.

Blue Ribbon	\$3.00
Red Ribbon	\$2.00
White Ribbon	\$1.00

1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place will be chosen in each of the four age divisions:

1 st Place in Class Rosette =	\$5.00
2 nd Place in Class Rosette =	\$4.00
3 rd Place in Class Rosette =	\$3.00
Green Participation Ribbon =	\$0

The 1st place winner from each division will compete for Best in Show.

Overall all Awards:

Most Creative	Rosette & \$10.00	
Best Team Theme	Rosette & \$10.00	(Youth & Rabbit Team)
Best Homemade Costume	Rosette & \$10.00	
Best in Show	Trophy & \$15.00	

Youth showing in the Open Rabbit Show **MUST** complete the Rabbit Fashion Show application **and** Rabbits must go through the Rabbit Fashion Show inspection in order to show in the Rabbit Fashion Show.
