DIVISIONS: There will be four (4) Divisions:

1. Pee Wee 7 Years old and under
2. Junior Division (8-10)
3. Intermediate Division (11-13)
2. Senior Division (14-18)

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Contest is scheduled for Saturday, April 8, 2023, beginning at 3:00 PM in the Livestock Barn.
2. Contestant **MUST** wear long pants and closed toes shoes to compete.
3. Youth contestants will have 45 seconds to perform their whip cracking ability. Pee Wee will have 30 seconds.
4. Whips can be from 6-14 feet long
5. In case of a tie, there will be a pop-off to determine the winner.
6. Judges will score on a scale of 1-10 (10 being highest score) based on most original sharpness, loudness, and best overall performance.
7. **Contestant Conduct:** Any unbecoming behavior of contestant will be grounds for immediate disqualification and all awards, prizes and premiums will be forfeited.
8. *Contestant will be disqualified of found cracking at ANY TIME other than in the arena during the contest.*
