

WELCOME TO CLAY FAIR RV PARK

This is a private RV park, not affiliated with the parks & recreation department RV lots located on the fairground. This RV Park is for **temporary** use only. All RV sites are back-ins with water, sewer and electric (20, 30 and 50 amp) No group activities or rallies are allowed in the park.

The Clay County Fairground Association office is at 2493 SR-16 (the log cabin building) hours are weekdays 9 a.m.– 4 p.m. The office telephone number is (904)284-1615 and email is info@claycountyfair.org

Reservations are made online at claycountyfair.org.

Rates are as follows:

Daily RV Park rental \$35/day (1-6 days)

Weekly RV Park rental \$30/day (7-29 days)

Monthly RV Park rental \$25/day (30- or 31-days max of 90 days unless approved)

Reservations are accepted on a month-to-month basis. **THIS IS NOT AN EXTENDED STAY PARK. BLACK-OUT DATES ARE LISTED ON THIS WEBSITE.**

Check-in is 2 p.m.; Check-out is 11 a.m. Late check-out may be arranged with the park host but an additional charge may be applicable.

New arrivals should check in with the RV host. Our hosts have a sign in their space to identify them. The Park host can also be reached at (904)460-5495. If a park host is not available, park in an open site and leave a message on the park host telephone with your name and location.

The RV Park Host and management has the authority to refuse any rig that does not meet our standards. Management has the authority to refuse any person's entry, and/or have them and their belongings removed from the park.

Cancellations:

Cancellations outside of 24 hours (1 Day) prior to your arrival date will result in a \$35 cancellation fee for all reservations.

No refunds are given on or after arrival. No refunds will be issued for early check-out.

Cancellations will be refunded in the form that was used for the payment.

PARK RULES

CAMPGROUND ETIQUETTE

- Our road is one way with a speed limit of 5 mph at all times.
- Guest safety and security is of utmost importance to us. We ask that you give the gate code to **no one** and that you open the gate from the inside pad for a guest or delivery services. If someone at the gate requests entry, suggest they contact the RV park host by phone. The number is on the sign outside the gate.

- Campers are responsible for their visitors. Each visitor must register with the RV Park Host of office upon arrival. Visitors of park guests must leave by 10:00 pm.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. - 6 a.m. Generators are not allowed. There should be no loud music or excessive noise heard from a distance of 20 feet. Offenders may be asked to leave the park and there will be no refunds.
- Discharge of firearms or fireworks is prohibited.
- The use of unregistered motorized vehicles in the park is prohibited. To preserve guest privacy, drones are also prohibited.
- Children are welcome at our RV park. Please ensure that your children are under your supervision at all times. Running or walking through other guests' sites is prohibited.
- No more than 2 Vehicles per RV site. Park your vehicles directly in front of your RV or on yourRV site.
- Use of park water to wash vehicles is prohibited.
- There are no laundry facilities in the park. Do not hang clotheslines in the RV park.
- Only gray and black water should be discharged into our septic system. RV and marine toilet tissue (available at retail stores, camping stores and marinas) will protect your RV as well as our septic system. Plastic items, baby wipes and other cleaning wipes, feminine hygiene products and any other trash need to go into the dumpster with your trash. Children playing in the campground must be supervised and understand that nothing (including stones) should be put in the storm or sewer drains.
- A dumpster is near the entrance gate of the park. Please keep your site neat and clean. Our dumpsters are for guest use only. Please do not discard construction materials in the dumpster.
- Campfires are not allowed.
- RV park is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- We do not allow window a/c units in the RV's.

BATHHOUSE ETIQUETTE

- Please help us provide a clean and safe place for guests to shower by cleaning up after yourself.
- Take all personal items when you leave; items left behind will be discarded. Do not rinse muddy boots in shower stalls; a hose is provided for that purpose at the dump station near the south bathhouse.
- Please do not use bathhouse receptacles for household trash.
- Report any issues needing immediate attention to our park host or to the front office.

PET ETIQUETTE

- We are pet-friendly. Two mannered dogs per permitted per campsite.
- Barking and whining dogs will not be tolerated and may result in the owner's expulsion.
- Dogs within the RV park must be on a physical leash not exceeding 6 feet. For the safety of your dog and campers alike, please do not leave pets tied out or unattended.
- Pet waste must be picked up and disposed of properly. This rule is strictly enforced.
- Guests are invited to allow dogs to run off-leash at the pet-play area. Please pick up after your pet; waste bags are provided.
- Pets are not allowed inside bathhouses but dog-wash stations are located at each bathhouse; please rinse tubs after use. Report any issues to a park host.
